CONVICTION: Criminal Vehicular Operation  
SENTENCE: The Court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for 1 year and 1 day and ordered the defendant to pay a fine in the amount of \$50 plus surcharges to be deducted from prison wages, have no direct or indirect contact with the victims and provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: The Court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for a period of 36 months with the sentence running concurrent to the Criminal Vehicular Operation file sentence, the defendant was ordered to pay a fine in the amount of \$50, to be deducted from prison wages, and the Court waived the surcharge, have no direct or indirect contact with the victims and provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 15 months. Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for five years with the following conditions: 1) serve 248 days jail with credit for 248 days served; 2) pay \$50 fine plus surcharge; 3) complete an anger management treatment program; 4) complete out-patient and aftercare chemical dependency treatment; 5) abstain from the use of chemical, including alcohol, and submit to random testing; 6) seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification; 7) no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding; 8) cooperate with the rules and regulations of Intensive Supervision; 9) provide a DNA sample per statute.

Count II - Gross Misdemeanor DUI: Pay a \$3,000 fine and serve 365 days jail with \$2,500 of the fine and 250 days of the jail time suspended for four years with the same conditions as for Count I with the addition that the defendant participate in a MADD Victim Impact Panel.

Count III - 5th Degree Assault: Pay a \$3,000 fine and serve 1 year in jail with \$2,950 of the fine was stayed and all of the jail time was stayed with the same conditions as in Count I and he is to pay the fine.

SENTENCE: \$3,000 and 365 days in jail, \$2,950 and 275 days were suspended for two years on the following conditions: 1) Supervised probation for up to two years; 2) Serve 90 days in the Washington County Jail, with credit for time served; defendant may serve the jail time on Electronic Home Monitoring, and must report for orientation within 30 days; criteria were waived; 3) Pay a \$50 fine and surcharges on a schedule to be determined by court administration; 4) Have no assaultive behavior, and obtain an anger management assessment and follow all recommendations; 5) Complete a cognitive skills program evaluation and follow all recommendations; 6) Abstain from the use of mood altering chemicals, including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis at his own expense; 7) Complete the Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual Program (RUDI); 8) Have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with probation; and 9) Provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis.
