SENTENCE: Imposition of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for up to five years on the following conditions: Be law abiding, provide a DNA sample under 609.117, pay a fine of \$300 plus surcharge, 4 months to pay.

Orientation after sentence review hearing on 3/23/09. 2) Pay \$50 fine plus surcharges. 3) Complete intensive (minimum of 12 weeks) outpatient chemical dependency treatment, to be done before jail. 4) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzer testing at own expense, baseline at time of sentencing. 5) Complete a literacy evaluation through the Hubbs Center, and follow all recommendations. 6) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 7) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his County/State of residence. 8) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

following conditions: 1) Supervised probation for one year; 2) Serve 10 days in jail, with credit for three days served; defendant may serve the time on in or out-of-custody Sentence to Service, and criteria waived; 3) Pay \$100 fine and surcharges on a schedule to be determined by Court Administration; 4) Abide by the Order for Protection in effect with respect to victim contact; 5) Complete a domestic abuse evaluation, anger management or parenting assessment and all recommendations; 6) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare; 7) Abstain from the use of mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis at his own expense; 8) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide written verification to the supervising probation agent; and 9) Have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding and cooperate with probation.
