DATE: 7/30/2009

DEFENDANT: James Aaron McLafferty

DOB: 5/10/1974

CITY/RESIDENCE: Moundsview, MN

AGENCY: Oakdale Police Department

CONVICTION: I: Aiding and Abetting Burglary in the 3rd Degree; II: Theft from a Vacant Building

SENTENCE: On Count 1 the defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 29 months and ordered to pay a \$50 fine. On Count 2, the defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for one year and one day, to run concurrent with Count 1.

SENTENCE: The defendant was sentenced under a stay of imposition and placed on probation for a period of 3 years subject to the following: serve 90 days in the Washington County Jail, pay a fine in the amount of \$200, restitution to be left open for 30 days, have no direct or indirect contact with the victims, complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming and follow all recommendations, abstain from all mood-altering chemicals and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers, attend AA once a week for a year, attend a MADD Victim Impact Panel, write letters of apology to the victims and provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis.

CONVICTION: 5th Degree Controlled Substance

SENTENCE: Supervised probation for up to 10 years; 2) serve 365 days in jail, with credit for 3 days served; the defendant must serve 180 days on the in-custody Sentence to Service; the balance may be served on Electronic Home Monitoring (criteria waived); 3) pay \$300 fine and surcharges; alternatively, the defendant may work off the fine on Sentence to Service; 4) complete a chemical dependency evaluation at the Veterans Administration hospital and follow all recommendations, including aftercare; 5) complete a psychological evaluation through the VA hospital and follow all recommendations; 6) abstain from the use of mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis at own expense; 7) seek and

maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation agent; 8) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with all conditions of probation, and 9) cooperate with the transfer of probation to county of residence.

SENTENCE: Stay of adjudication, 5 years probation on the following conditions: 1) Serve 83 days in the Washington County Jail; to be released directly to Progress Valley Halfway House; defendant's parents to transport; 2) Pay a fine in the amount of \$50 plus surcharges on a schedule to be determined by Washington County Court Administration; 3) Successfully complete chemical dependency treatment, after care, and halfway house or sober living at the direction of Human Service, Inc. and the supervising probation officer; 4) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense; 5) Attend AA/NA meetings two times per week for 12 months and provide verification; 6) Seek and maintain gainful employment or full-time schooling and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; 7) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with the standard conditions of probation; and 8) Complete the RUDI (Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual) Program.

prescribed; obtain GED; no same or similar; restitution of \$11,369.24; provide Washington County Court Services with a business plan or certificates.
