DEFENDANT: Giavauntai Shainiece Stewart

AGENCY: Oakdale Police Department

CONVICTION: Aiding and Abetting Theft by Check

SENTENCE: Imposition of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for 10 years with the following conditions: 1) serve 30 days jail, which can be done on Electronic Home Monitor; 2) pay \$50 fine plus surcharge; 3) pay restitution in the amount of \$2,068.30 to Home Goods Store and this is joint and several with the co-defendant; 4) complete mental health assessment and follow the recommendations unless probation officer deems it unnecessary; 5) no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding; 6) cooperate with the transfer of probation to county of residence; 7) provide a DNA sample.

SENTENCE: (1) Serve six days in jail, with credit for six days served; (2) pay a \$50 fine and surcharges on a schedule to be determined by Court Administration; (3) obtain a Cognitive Skills Programming evaluation and follow all recommendations; (4) complete an updated chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare; (5) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses at his own expense; (6) attend MADD Victim Impact Panel; (7) seek and maintain gainful employment, and (8) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with probation.

SENTENCE: Imposition of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for five years with the following conditions: 1) serve 72 days jail with credit for 72 days; 2) pay \$50 fine plus surcharge; 3) no direct or in-direct contact with the victim; 4) complete all mental health programming, including taking prescribed medication at the direction of his mental health professional; 5) complete the 18 week

therapy program at Human Services Inc. and follow any recommendations for continued therapy; 6) abstain from the use of chemicals, including alcohol, submit to random testing and provide a baseline today; 7) seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification; 8) no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding; 9) defendant is not to possess any weapons; 10) provide a DNA sample; 11) cooperate with the transfer of probation to county of residence.

SENTENCE: Court stayed the execution of sentence and placed defendant on probation for 5 years on the following conditions: 1) serve 150 days in jail with credit for 4 days, to be performed in-custody Sentence to Service, Huber or straight time; 2) pay \$300 fine; 3) no direct or indirect contact with the victim; 4) complete an anger management evaluation and follow all recommendations; 5) abstain from all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis and breathalyzers at own expense; 6) provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis; 7) no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation; 8) do not enter any establishment whose primary business is the serving of alcohol; 9) restitution ordered.
