SENTENCE: Imposition of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for five years with the following conditions: 1) 23 days jail with credit for 13 days, the rest can be done on in- or out-of-custody Sentence to Service; 2) \$100 fine plus surcharge; 3) \$2,577 restitution to Pepsi Bottling Company; 4) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow the recommendations, including aftercare; 5) abstain from the use of chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing; 6) no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding; 7) cooperate with the transfer of probation to county of residence; 8) provide a DNA sample.
