CONVICTION: Theft from Person  
SENTENCE: Court stayed imposition of sentence and placed defendant on probation for a period of 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 60 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 12 days served; time to be served as straight time. 2) Follow all the standard conditions of the Intensive Supervision Unit, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 3) Have no direct or indirect contact with victims. 4) Complete an intake for cognitive skills programming and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 5) Complete a mental health evaluation and follow all recommendations at the direction of the mental health professional, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 6) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation within 10 days of sentencing and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 7) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. A baseline urinalysis to be provided on day of sentencing. 8) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 9) Defendant ordered to complete the RUDI (Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual) Program. 10) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. The court imposed a \$50 fine plus fees.

for cognitive skills, mental health programming, or other similar men's programming available in his county of residence, and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 3) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. A baseline urinalysis to be provided on day of sentencing. If urinalysis is positive, it is recommended he obtain a chemical dependency evaluation and follow recommendations for completing a treatment program. Waive/defer fee. 4) Seek and maintain gainful employment or full-time school, and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 5) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 6) Follow all the standard conditions of the Intensive Supervision Unit, if a Washington County resident, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 7) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county of residence. 8) Defendant has provided a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. Court imposed a \$50 fine plus surcharges.

Time may be served on work release, in-custody Sentence to Serve, or out-of-custody Sentence to Serve with criteria waived. 3) Provide an urinalysis today. If the urinalysis is positive, the defendant is ordered to complete an updated chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations including aftercare plans. If the urinalysis is negative, no new chemical dependency evaluation is ordered. 4) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random testing at his own expense. 5) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with the standard conditions of probation. 6) Defendant is ordered to complete his high school equivalency unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 7) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. 8) Attend AA/NA meetings weekly and obtain a sponsor.

Complete 30 days and follow recommendations. 5) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at her own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 6) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 7) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. 8) Be evaluated and if accepted participate and successfully complete the Offender Recovery Program and follow all directives and recommendations of the program, as deemed necessary by the supervising agent.
