The City of Cottage Grove, in partnership with the South Washington Watershed District, retrofit their deicing equipment on the City's fleet of plow trucks to enable a reduction of the material applied to roads and achieve better results. The South Washington Watershed District will collect flow data and chloride samples from two small subwatersheds that will be used to document decreases in annual chloride load and assess the benefit of funding future deicing equipment upgrades. Please come and learn about the City of Cottage Groves experience with upgrading, operating, and effectiveness of the updated equipment on the plow trucks, and the South Washington Watershed Districts analysis of chloride loads for the winter of 2010 – 2011.
