DATE: 11/25/2008
DEFENDANT: Richard Ronald Zaspel
DOB: 3/11/1975
CITY/RESIDENCE: Maplewood, MN
AGENCY: Oakdale Police Department
CONVICTION: Aiding and Abetting Assault in the 1st Degree
SENTENCE: Defendant committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 110 months under a stay of execution and placed on probation for a period of 20 years subject to the following conditions: serve one year local jail time, defendant to report on Friday, December 26, Thinking for Change Program, complete the Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual Program, complete an anger management assessment, \$1,986.18 in restitution to the Crime Victims Reparations Board, \$1,986.06 in restitution to victim, have no contact with victim, provide a DNA sample, abstain from all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random testing.

CONVICTION: Negligent Storage of Firearm
SENTENCE: 365 days in jail and \$3000 fine with 362 days and \$2700 stayed to probation for 2 years on following conditions: 1) Placed on probation for 2 years. 2) Serve 3 days in jail with credit for 3 days served. 3) Pay a \$300 fine, plus surcharges. 4) Complete an evaluation for domestic abuse and/or anger management and follow all recommendations. 5) Abstain from alcohol and non-prescribed drugs and test at his own expense. 6) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 7) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. 8) Have no possession of weapons while on probation supervision and to be subject to any rules that apply after his release from probation supervision.

SENTENCE: Committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 19 months with a stay of execution of sentence and Court placed defendant on probation for 10 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 180 days in jail with credit for 64 days served. 2) Pay \$50 fine plus surcharges. 3) Complete a psychological evaluation and follow all recommendations. 4) Complete all chemical dependency aftercare. 5) Attend AA/NA meetings 2 times per week for 9 months and provide verification. 6) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification. 7) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 8) Follow all the standard conditions of the Intensive Supervision Unit should he obtain Washington County residency. 9) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county of residence. 10) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: Court stayed the imposition of sentence pursuant to 152.18 and placed the defendant on probation for up to 5 years on the following conditions: Serve 7 days in the Washington County jail with credit for 7 days served, pay fine of \$200, plus surcharges, complete outpatient chemical dependency treatment and follow all release recommendations, abstain from use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol and submit to random testing; attend AA/NA meetings one time per week for 6 months and provide verification, be law abiding, and cooperate with the transfer of supervision to the county of residence.

full length domestic violence therapy group and follow any recommendations for counseling. 4) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at own expense. 5) No same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 6) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his County/State of residence. 7) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: \$3000 fine with \$2900 stayed, 365 days with 360 stayed, credit for 5 days, probation for 2 years under the following conditions: follow the rules of probation, no same or similar offenses, no acts of violence and obtain an anger management assessment and follow all recommendations.

Pay fine in the amount of \$500 plus surcharge. Complete chemical dependency evaluation within 10 days and follow all recommendations, abstain from use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol and submit to random testing, be law abiding and cooperate with transfer of supervision to county or state of residence.

CONVICTION: Criminal Damage to Property in the 4th Degree; Misdemeanor Trespass

SENTENCE: On Criminal Damage to Property in the 4th Degree, the Court sentenced defendant as follows: 90 days and \$1000 fine; 67 days and \$500 fine stayed for 1 year on the condition that defendant follow the recommendations of chemical dependency evaluation, abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals including alcohol, successfully complete "New Choices for Recovery," attend AA weekly for 3 months and

have no contact with the victims and their residence, although an apology letter may be submitted through probation; restitution investigation, defendant ordered to pay the amount but can challenge it. On Misdemeanor Trespass, the Court suspended all of the jail and fine on the condition that defendant complete probation successfully on Criminal Damage to Property in the 4th Degree conviction, also no same or similar offenses, and remain law abiding.
