CONVICTION: 5th Degree Possession
SENTENCE: Court stayed adjudication of sentence and placed Defendant on probation for 5 years on following conditions: 1) Serve 120 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 31 days served. If Defendant completes in jail treatment he can request to be furloughed to Sober Housing or 1/2 way house. 2) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 3) Complete New Choices for Recovery in-custody chemical dependency treatment and follow all recommendations, including aftercare, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. Defendant to enter and complete sober living situation when released from jail. 4) Follow all the standard conditions of the Intensive Supervision Unit should he obtain a permanent Washington County residence, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 5) Complete a Cognitive Skills Programming Intake and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 6) Obtain his GED and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 7) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 8) Cooperate with the transfer of probation if moves/lives outside of Washington County. Pay \$50 fine plus fees.
