

**SENTENCING FOR
THE WEEK OF 5/10/2010**

DATE: 5/6/2010
DEFENDANT: Joshua Allen Schreiber
DOB: 11/2/1988
CITY/RESIDENCE: Hugo, MN
AGENCY: Washington County Sheriff's Office
CONVICTION: Financial Transaction Card Fraud - Use - No Consent
SENTENCE: The Court stayed imposition of sentence and placed the Defendant on probation for 5 years on the following conditions: 1) Defendant ordered to serve 4 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 4 days served. Time to be served on in or out-of-custody Sentence to Service. 2) Pay restitution if requested within 30 days of sentencing, through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer. 3) Complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 4) Complete a psychological or mental health evaluation and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary and sign release for prior psych evaluation at St. Joseph's. 5) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 6) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. A baseline urinalysis to be submitted on the day of sentencing. 7) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county of residence, if appropriate. 8) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 9) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. Court imposed a \$1,000 fine, stayed \$785, pay \$215 plus fees for a total of \$300.

AGENCY: Washington County Sheriff's Office
CONVICTION: Traffic - DWI - First Degree Driving While Impaired
SENTENCE: Court committed defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for 36 months, executions stayed and defendant placed on probation for a period of 7 years on the following conditions: 1) Serve 180 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 2 days served. Time to be served is recommended on Work Release or in or out-of-custody Sentence to Service, criteria waived, or combination thereof. 2) Participate in Electronic Alcohol Monitoring (if available) for 30 days during each year of his probation, in addition to any other conditions. 3) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 4) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 5) Attend AA/NA meetings 1 time per week for 3 months and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 6) Attend a MADD Victim Impact Panel, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 7) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 8) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 9) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his County/State of residence. 10) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. Court ordered \$3,000 fine, stayed \$2,950, pay \$50 plus fees.

CONVICTION: Terroristic Threats
SENTENCE: Stay of Imposition, 5 years probation on the following: 1) Defendant be ordered to serve 40 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 30 days served. 2) Have no direct or indirect contact with the deputy at the Washington County Sheriff's Department. 3) Complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming and follow all recommendations. 4) Complete anger management with Dennis Smith. Defendant be ordered to make an appointment within 30 days of sentencing. 5) Complete intensive outpatient chemical dependency treatment at St. John's Hospital. 6) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense. 7) Attend AA/NA meetings two times per week for 12 months and provide verification. 8) Consult with a psychiatrist to determine appropriate medications to treat his ADHD and possible depression and anxiety. 9) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 10) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county of residence. 11) Pursuant to §609.117, defendant be ordered to provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. 12) \$50 fine plus surcharges.

CONVICTION: Felony Violation of Domestic Abuse No Contact Order
SENTENCE: Court committed Defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for 21 months, stayed execution of sentence and placed the Defendant on probation for 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 191 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 191 days served. 2) Have no direct or indirect contact with the victim, unless otherwise requested by her. Probationary Domestic Abuse No Contact Order signed. 3) Complete Bob Kelly's 12 week Domestic Violence Program and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 4) Seek and maintain gainful employment or schooling and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 5) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 6) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his County/State of residence. 7) Display no threatening or assaultive behavior.
