DATE: 3/10/2010

DEFENDANT: Timothy James Rubbelke

DOB: 3/28/1972

CITY/RESIDENCE: St Paul, MN

AGENCY: Forest Lake Police Department

CONVICTION: Check Forgery - Make or Alter Check

SENTENCE: Defendant committed to Commissioner of Corrections for 26 months, credit for time served since date of offense, concurrent with time serving on another matter. Restitution ordered \$93.37 to TCF Bank, \$677.43 to Kwik Trip, Restitution held open for 30 days so other victims can submit affidavits. The judge agreed to review and add to restitution as appropriate; \$50 fine plus surcharges; restitution docketed and reduced to judgment. DNA already on file.

SENTENCE: (1) Supervised probation for up to ten years; (2) serve 180 days in jail on the in-custody Sentence to Service Program (criteria waived); (3) complete all mental health programming, including taking all prescribed medications at the direction of his mental health professional; (4) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses at his own expense; (5) complete the ADAP Chemical Dependency Treatment Program and follow any additional recommendations; (6) attend AA/NA twice per week for six months and provide verification to the supervising probation agent; (7) commit no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with the standard conditions of probation; (8) cooperate with the transfer of his probation to his county of residence; (9) provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis, and (10) pay a \$50 fine and surcharges within one year.

verification; 5) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 6) cooperate with the transfer of supervision to county of residence; 7) provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: Fifth Degree Controlled Substance Crime: (1) supervised probation for up to five years; (2) serve two days in jail, with credit for two days served; (3) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses at his own expense; (4) complete all mental health programming until a mental health professional and the supervising probation agent no longer deem it necessary; (5) commit no same or similar offenses, have no alcohol or drug-related convictions, remain law abiding, and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation.

DUI: the defendant received the following sentence: 90 days jail and a \$1,000 fine with 88 days suspended and \$100 suspended on the following conditions: (1) supervised probation for up to two years; (2) serve two days in jail, with credit for two days served; (3) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses at his own expense; (4) complete all mental health programming until such time as the mental health practitioner and his supervising probation agent no longer deem it necessary; (5) attend a MADD Victim Impact Panel; (6) have no same or similar offenses, have no alcohol, drug-related or driver license convictions, and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation; the defendant will pay a \$900 fine on a schedule to be determined by the Court Administrator's Office.

Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for ten years with the following conditions: 1) serve 180 days in Washington County Jail with credit for 15 days served; 2) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans; 3) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing; 4) complete all mental health programming, including taking all prescribed medication; 5) seek and maintain gainful employment and provide proof to supervising probation officer; 6) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation; 7) provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis; 8) pay a \$300 fine.

SENTENCE: (1) Supervised probation for up to five years; (2) defendant must serve 10 days on the out-of-custody Sentence to Service Program (criteria waived); (3) complete a day treatment focusing on dialectical behavior therapy skills; (4) participate in individual therapy; (5) complete a medical evaluation and take all prescribed medications; (6) have no unsupervised adult contact with her younger sister, unless authorized by mental health professionals or the supervising probation agent; (7) maintain gainful employment and provide verification from the supervising probation agent; (8) engage in no assaultive or threatening behavior, remain law abiding, and cooperate with standard conditions of probation; (9) cooperate with the transfer of her probation to her county of residence; (10) defendant to provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis, and (11) pay a \$300 fine and surcharges or perform 30 hours of Community Work Service in lieu of the fine and surcharges within 120 days.

SENTENCE: 365 days in jail and a \$3,000 fine, with 330 days and \$2,500 suspended for two years on the following conditions: (1) 30 days in jail, to be served on the out-of-custody Sentence to Service Program; (2) supervised probation for two years; (3) complete the Hazelden Fellowship Club Aftercare Program and follow all recommendations; (4) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses and breathalyzers at his own expense; (5) complete individual psychotherapy or domestic abuse programming at the direction of mental health professionals, and (6) attend AA meetings three times per week for one year and provide verification to the supervising probation agent; (7) defendant may not use, possess or have access to firearms; (8) commit no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with standard conditions of probation; (9) provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis, and (10) pay a \$500 fine and surcharges.
