CONVICTION: Theft
SENTENCE: The defendant was placed on probation for a period of 2 years subject to the following conditions: 1) Serve 31 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 32 days served, 2) Pay restitution if requested within 30 days, 3) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random testing at his own expense, 4) Complete all mental health programming, 5) Follow all recommendations of the Intensive Supervision Unit, 6) Complete an intake for Cognitive Skills Programming, 7) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis and 8) Pay a fine of \$100 plus \$85 surcharge.

First 30 on straight time, balance on out-of-custody Sentence to Service, 4) Follow all the standard conditions of Sex Offender Unit, 5) Follow all the recommendations of the psycho-sexual evaluation from Human Services, Inc., 6) Have no unsupervised contact with minors pending psycho-sexual recommendations, 7) Cannot own/use/possess a computer or have access to the internet unless approved to do so by supervising agent and/or sex therapist. If and/or when computer/internet use is approved, computer, software or storage disks will be subject to random searches and monitoring, 8) Submit to polygraph testing, 9) Actively seek and maintain employment unless enrolled in higher education, 10) Abstain from the use of all non-prescribed mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random testing at his own expense, 11) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation, and 12) Pay a fine in the amount of \$50
