CONVICTION: Ineligible Voter Knowingly Votes
SENTENCE: 365 days in jail and a \$3,000 fine, with 365 days and \$2,900 suspended for two years on the following conditions: (1) supervised probation for two years; (2) perform 60 hours Community Work Service within 60 months; (3) commit no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with standard conditions of probation; (4) pay a \$100 fine, surcharge, and law library fee; (5) sign releases of information to monitor her medication.

(1) Serve 120 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 43 days served; remainder: 240 hours can be served as Community Work Service at locations approved by probation and in-custody Sentence to Service; (2) defendant is ordered to pay restitution; (3) sign appropriate releases and continue all current mental health programming, including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary, and complete current programming at Pathways; (4) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; (5) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation; (6) cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county/state of residence, and (7) sign appropriate releases and provide proof of recent chemical dependency treatment and aftercare unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary.

Court ordered 40 hours of Community Work Service but stayed it as long as defendant is compliant. 2) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 3) Attend AA/NA meetings 1 time per week for 3 months and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 4) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation.

On Count 2: 90 days with 89 stayed, \$1000 fine with \$1000 stayed. 1 year probation, on following conditions: 1) Defendant placed on probation under the supervision of Washington County Community Corrections for a period of 1 year. 2) Serve 1 day in the Washington County Jail with credit for 1 day served. 3) Attend a MADD Victim Impact Panel, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 4) Perform 40 hours Community Work Service stayed as long as defendant compliant with probation. 5) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 6) Attend AA/NA meetings 1 time per week for 3 months and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 7) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. Count 2 concurrent to Count 1. Court imposed a \$400 fine plus fees.
