SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 13 months with credit for 35 days. He is to pay a \$50 fine.

SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 13 months. Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for five years with the following conditions: 1) 130 days jail; 2) \$50 fine; 3) complete a cognitive skills evaluation; 4) abstain from the use of alcohol and chemicals and submit to random testing; 5) attend AA once per week; 6) seek and maintain gainful employment; 6) complete a South Oaks gambling screen; 7) remain law abiding; 8) provide DNA sample.

The Court stayed the execution of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for a period of up to 5 years. The Court also ordered that the defendant be subject to the following conditions: 1) serve 116 days in the Washington County jail with credit for 116 days

served; 2) pay a fine in the amount of \$50 plus surcharges; 3) pay restitution in the amount of \$303.53 to St. Paul Park Auto Parts through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer. Restitution to be paid joint and several with any co-defendants; 4) complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 5) complete treatment at Faith Family in Hastings, Minnesota and complete any recommended aftercare plans and provide proof of completion to supervising probation officer; 6) abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at her own expense unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 7) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 8) cooperate with the transfer of supervision to county/state of residence. The defendant has previously provided a biological sample.

SENTENCE: \$3,000 fine and 365 days in jail, with \$2,500 of the fine and 320 days suspended for two years on the following conditions: (1) supervised probation for two years; (2) serve 45 days in jail, with credit for three days served; the Court authorized him to serve the 45 days in jail under the Electronic Home Monitoring Program, and criteria were waived; (3) pay a \$500 fine and surcharges on a schedule to be determined by Court Administration; (4) have no direct or indirect contact with the victim, except as may be authorized in a court proceedings or through attorneys for the victim and the defendant; (5) continue the current program of mental health and take all prescribed medications at the request of any mental health professional; (6) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with standard conditions of probation; (7) cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to the defendant's county of residence; defendant is prohibited from possessing firearms; (9) defendant to commit no threatening or assaultive behavior, and (10) defendant to provide a DNA sample.
