DATE: 7/17/2009

DEFENDANT: Lisa Marie Betterley

DOB: 10/16/1968

CITY/RESIDENCE: Inver Grove Heights, MN

AGENCY: Oakdale Police Department

CONVICTION: Forgery

SENTENCE: Committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 17 months, stayed the execution of sentence and placed on probation for 5 years under the following conditions: 1) serve 90 days in jail, served under any alternative in which qualified for, credit for 51 days; 2) pay \$300 fine; 3) restitution ordered; 4) no direct or indirect contact with the victims, 5) complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming; 6) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at own expense; 7) no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 8) provide a DNA sample per statute; 9) complete the (RUDI) Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual Program.

CONVICTION: Check Forgery

SENTENCE: On the charge of Check Forgery the court stayed the imposition of sentence and placed the defendant on probation under the supervision of Washington County Community Corrections for a period of 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 12 days in the Washington County Jail w/credit for 12 days served. 2) Perform 16 hours of Community Work Service by October 1, 2009. 3) Pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by court administration. 4) Complete an evaluation for cognitive skills programming and follow all recommendations. 5) Complete a psychological evaluation and follow all recommendations. 6) Provide verification of completion of chemical dependency treatment and attendance at a half way house. 7) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at her own expense. 8) Attend AA/NA meetings one time per week for three months and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 9) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 10) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation. 11) Cooperate with the transfer of her supervision to her county of residence. 12) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: The court stayed the imposition of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 22 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 22 days served. 2) Pay a fine of \$200 plus surcharges. 3) Pay restitution in the amount of \$1543.61 to State Farm Insurance and pay restitution in the amount of \$1,000 to victim through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer. 4) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations including after care plans. 5) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense. 6) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 7) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation.

SENTENCE: On the charge of Terroristic Threats the court sentenced the defendant to 365 days and a \$3,000 fine w/335 days and \$2,000 suspended for three years under the following conditions: 1) The defendant be placed on probation under supervision of Washington County Community Corrections for three years. 2) Serve 30 days w/credit for 1 day served and the time may be served on Electronic Home Monitoring. 3) Pay a fine of \$1,000 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by court administration. 4) Have no direct or indirect contact with victim. 5) Complete an anger management assessment and follow all subsequent recommendations unless the supervising probation officer deems in unnecessary. 6) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation. 7) Defendant is ordered to submit a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

including alcohol, and submit to random testing at own expense; 6) follow all recommendations of a recently completed psycho-sexual evaluation and cooperate and complete sex offender treatment and follow all recommendations; 7) follow all the standard conditions of the Sex Offender Unit; 8) no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 9) no direct or indirect contact with the victim; 10) cooperate and comply with polygraph exams; 11) register as a predatory offender; 12) provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: 19 months, stay of execution, 5 years probation on the following conditions: 1) Defendant to serve 87 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 87 days served; 2) Pay a fine in the amount of \$50 plus surcharges; 3) Complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming, if available in county of residence, and follow all recommendations; 4) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation within 30 days of sentencing and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans; 5) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at her own expense; 6) Attend AA/NA meetings 2 times per week and provide verification; 7) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 8) Cooperate with the transfer of probation supervision to her county/state of residence; and 9) No contact with victim.

SENTENCE: \$1,000 fine and 90 days jail with \$800 of the fine and 85 days suspended for two years. 1) probation for 2 years; 2) serve 5 days in jail, credit for 1 day, to be served as Community Work Service 32 hours; 3) pay \$50 fine; 4) complete Domestic Abuse Program counseling; 5) abstain from all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at own expense; 6) attend AA a minimum of 1 time per week for as long as probation officer deems it; 7) no same or similar offenses, no assaultive or threatening behavior, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 8) comply with any valid Order for Protection in place regarding contact; 9) certify as petty after 2 years if compliant with probation.

Jail time to be completed prior to October 2009; 2) pay \$50 fine; 3) restitution ordered; 4) abstain from all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at own expense; 5) in the event of a positive drug test, complete a chemical dependency evaluation; 6) complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming in county of residence; 7) seek and maintain gainful employment; 8) no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 9) cooperate with transfer of supervision to county of residence; 10) provide a DNA sample per statute.
