DEFENDANT: Brandon Robert Wolff

AGENCY: Stillwater Police Department
CONVICTION: Assault in the Fifth Degree
SENTENCE: The defendant was given 90 days jail and a \$1,000 fine. 90 days of the jail time and \$950 of the fine were stayed with the following conditions: 1) probation for 2 years; 2) no contact with the victim; 3) pay restitution through Washington County Court Administration of \$415.69 to Minnesota Crime Victims Reparations Board and \$14.25 to the victim; 4) no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding; 5) abstain from the use of alcohol and controlled substance, testing was not ordered but probation can demand them if they deem them necessary; 6) follow all instructions of probation; 7) pay a \$50 fine plus surcharges.
