DEFENDANT: Mary Etta Crew

CITY/RESIDENCE: ST PAUL, MN  
AGENCY: Stillwater Police Department  
CONVICTION: Fifth Degree Drug Possession  
SENTENCE: Five years' probation, with credit for 20 days' jail already served; obtain a chemical dependency evaluation and follow recommendations; abstain from alcohol and chemicals and submit to random testing; complete Cognitive Skills Programming; remain law abiding; cooperate with transfer of probation; pay a \$1,000 fine, but all of it stayed, and provide a DNA sample.
