DEFENDANT: Tracy Lee Phillips

CONVICTION: Terroristic Threats  
SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 1 year and 1 day with credit for 150 days. He is to have no contact with the victim, pay a \$50 fine plus surcharges and provide a DNA sample.

(2) Pay fine of \$900 plus surcharges; (3) Pay restitution, \$515 to Winnick Supply Company; (4) Complete evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming and follow recommendations; (5) Abstain and submit to random testing; (6) Complete chemical dependency evaluation and follow recommendations; (7) Be law abiding; (8) Cooperate with transfer of probation to county or state of residence; (9) Pursuant to 609.117, submit to biological specimen.

for a period of 5 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 53 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 53 days served. 2) Pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges. 3) Follow all the standard conditions of the Intensive Supervision Unit, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 4) Pay restitution in the amount of \$1,581.57 to victim through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer. Restitution is to be paid joint and several with her co-defendants. 5) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at her own expense. 6) Complete out-patient chemical dependency treatment including aftercare. 7) Complete a psychological evaluation and follow all recommendations. 8) Complete her GED and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 9) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 10) Provide a biological specimen for the purposes of DNA analysis.

Count II, Misdemeanor Driving While Impaired: The Court sentenced the defendant as follows: \$1,000 fine and 90 days in jail with \$950 of the fine and 37 days in jail suspended. 1) Defendant is placed on probation under the supervision of Washington County Community Corrections for 2 years. 2) Serve 53 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 53 days served. 3) Pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges. 4) Follow all the standard conditions of the Intensive Supervision Unit. 5) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at her own expense. 6) Complete out-patient chemical dependency treatment, including aftercare. 7) Complete a psychological evaluation and follow all recommendations. 8) Attend a MADD Victim Impact Panel. 9) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation.

The jail time to be served will be consecutive to the jail time on Court File 82-CR-06-619. The time may be served on in-custody Sentence to Service. 2) Pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges. 3) Have no direct or indirect contact with the victim. 4) Continue with all mental health programming, including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of his mental health professional. 5) Successfully complete outpatient chemical dependency treatment and follow all aftercare recommendations. 6) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense. 7) Attend AA/NA meetings one time per week for 12 months and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 8) Seek and maintain gainful employment or school and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 9)

Follow all the standard conditions of the Intensive Supervision Unit unless the supervising probation agent deems it unnecessary. 10) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation.
