

**SENTENCING FOR  
THE WEEK OF 2/4/2008**

DATE: 2/4/2008  
DEFENDANT: Sunshine Blue Miller-Bylund  
DOB: 2/4/1979  
CITY/RESIDENCE: St. Paul, MN  
AGENCY: Washington County Sheriff's Office  
CONVICTION: Aiding and Abetting Theft by Swindle  
SENTENCE: Imposition of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for five years with the following conditions:  
1) 30 days which can be done on Sentence to Service or home detention; 2) \$50 fine plus surcharge; 3) restitution is left open; 4) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow the recommendations; 5) abstain from the use of chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing; 6) no same or similar offenses and remain law abiding; 7) cooperate with the transfer of probation; 8) provide a DNA sample.

SENTENCE: The Court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for a period of 1 year and 1 day, stayed execution of sentence, placed the defendant on probation for a period not to exceed 10 years on the following conditions: (1) Serve 180 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 2 days served, in custody Sentence to Service; (2) Pay fine in the amount of \$100 plus surcharges; (3) Abstain from use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol and submit to random testing; (4) Have a chemical dependency evaluation and follow recommendations; (5) Have a psychological evaluation and follow recommendations; and (6) No same/similar offenses and be law abiding.

SENTENCE: The Court stayed the imposition of sentence and placed defendant on probation for a period not to exceed three years on the following conditions: (1) Serve 45 days in the Washington County Jail on out-of-custody Sentence to Service credit for one day; (2) Pay fine in the amount of \$50, plus surcharges; (3) Have no contact with victim; (4) Complete psycho-sexual evaluation at Human Services, Inc. and follow recommendations; (5) Participate in and pay for any polygraph testing per the instructions of supervising probation officer; (6) Do not possess or use a computer for internet services until it has been determined to be appropriate by therapists; (7) No same/similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with transfer of supervision to county of residence; (8) Register as a predatory offender pursuant to 243.166; (9) Provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis under 609.117.

SENTENCE: The defendant was given 365 days jail and a \$3,000 fine with 345 days jail and \$2,700 suspended for three years with the following conditions: 1) do the 20 days on work release; 2) pay the fine; 3) complete domestic abuse assessment and follow the recommendations; 4) complete an updated chemical dependency evaluation and follow the recommendations; 5) abstain from chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing; 6) no same or similar offenses and remain law abiding; 7) provide DNA sample.

SENTENCE: The Court stayed the imposition of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for up to 5 years on the following conditions: (1) Serve 30 days in the county jail on out-of-custody Sentence to Service with credit for 3 days, (2) Pay fine of \$500, plus surcharges, (3) Pay restitution in the amount of \$1,878 to Ryland Homes. (4) Have no same or similar offenses and be law abiding; (5) Cooperate with transfer of supervision to county or state of residence; (6) Provide a DNA sample.

SENTENCE: The Court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for a period of 42 months, stayed the execution of that sentence, placed the defendant on probation for a period not to exceed 7 years on the following conditions: (1) Serve 180 days in the Washington County Jail, 30 days to be served consecutively with credit for 88 days served, time to be served on in-custody Sentence to Service; (2) Pay fine of \$50, plus surcharge; (3) Serve 30 days on Electronic Home Alcohol Monitoring for each year of supervision; (4) Complete an evaluation for cognitive skills and follow recommendations; (5) Complete Driving With Care and follow recommendations; (6) Abstain and submit to random testing; (7) AA one time per week for 12 months and provide verification; (8) Complete aftercare program and provide verification; (9) Attend MADD Victim Impact Panel; (10) Seek and maintain gainful employment; (11) Complete Repeat Offender DWI Program, although Court indicated defendant didn't have to double up on things that would be included in the other conditions if they were also included in the Repeat Offender Program; (12) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding; (13) Provide a DNA sample pursuant to statute.

The defendant shall serve 24 months in prison and 12 months on supervised release. If defendant commits any disciplinary acts, the Commissioner may extend the amount of incarcerated time. The defendant was ordered to pay a fine in the amount of \$50 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration.

SENTENCE: Court sentenced the defendant to be committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 14 months, execution stayed to probation for 5 years on the following conditions: (1) serve 180 days in jail with credit for 124 days, (2) \$50 fine and fees, (3) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow recommendations for treatment, (4) complete sex offender treatment, (5) follow rules of sex offender probation, (6) take a polygraph test, (7) no contact with minors, (8) abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals and submit to random testing, (9) comply with sex offender registration, (10) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, (11) abide by the standard terms and conditions of probation.
