Washington County Criminal Defense Panel Legal Advice Clinic

**The Washington County Criminal Defense Panel has a new, free legal advice clinic –
CRIMINAL LEGAL ADVICE CLINIC - Starting June 2, 2010**

Who can use the Legal Advice Clinics?

You must be a current Washington County resident or be involved in a Washington County court case. There are no restrictions on income to use this free service.

What can the volunteer attorney help with?

Answers to legal questions, criminal law questions and criminal procedure questions.

What services are provided by the Criminal Advice Clinic?

You can receive a free 30-minute consultation from a volunteer attorney, who can offer advice and legal assistance regarding matters such as: traffic tickets, drivers license questions, misdemeanors, gross misdemeanors, felonies, probation violations, and expungements.

What services are NOT provided by the Criminal Legal Advice Clinic?

Juvenile law, child protection, termination of parental rights, probate and federal criminal issues.

Family law issues and civil law issues are covered by other advice clinics on other schedule dates and times.

How do I arrange to meet with the volunteer attorney?

The Criminal Advice Clinic is based on a first come-first serve basis. The clinic is offered between **10:00 am and 12:00 pm every Wednesday in the Washington County Self Service Center**. You do not need to schedule an appointment in advance.
