(3) Pay restitution in the amount of \$1,655 to victim through Washington County Court Administration; (4) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations; (5) Abstain and submit to random testing; (6) Seek and maintain gainful employment; (7) Be law abiding; (8) Complete high school education; (9) Provide a biological specimen pursuant to 609.117.

Time to be served on work release or in or out-of-custody Sentence to Service, if qualified/criteria waived; 2) Pay a fine in the amount of \$50 plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration; 3) Complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 4) Complete an evaluation for domestic abuse and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 5) Complete inpatient chemical dependency treatment and aftercare, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 6) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 7) Attend AA/NA meetings as directed by the treatment program and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; 8) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; 9) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 10) Pursuant to §609.117, provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis; and 11) Participate in the Intensive Supervision Program, if a Washington County resident.

conditions of probation; 7) Have no assaultive or threatening behavior; 8) Complete the

RUDI (Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual Program); and 9)  
Pursuant to §609.117, provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.
