

**SENTENCING FOR

DATE: 2/4/2010

DEFENDANT: Sommer Ann Hengemuehler

DOB: 5/22/1980

CITY/RESIDENCE: Hopkins, MN

AGENCY: Ramsey County Sheriff's Office

CONVICTION: Drugs - Fifth Degree Possession

SENTENCE: \$500 fine plus surcharges, 5 years probation on the following: 1) Serve 3 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 3 days served; 2) Complete all recommendations made by the chemical health assessment, including completing outpatient treatment and aftercare plans, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 3) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at her own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 4) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; and 5) Cooperate with the transfer of her supervision to her county/state of residence.

SENTENCE: (1) Supervised probation for up to five years; (2) serve 45 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for one day served; defendant may serve the balance of his sentence on in or out-of-custody Sentence to Service, and was granted permission to perform the STS in Olmsted County, where she resides, on the condition that she assume full responsibility for any fees associated with it; (3) pay restitution; (4) have no indirect or direct contact with victim; (5) complete all mental health programming; (6) complete outpatient chemical dependency treatment; (7) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals not prescribed for her, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalyses at her own expense; (8) seek and maintain gainful employment or attend school to obtain her GED; (9) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation; (10) cooperate with the transfer of supervision to her county of residence; (11) provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis, and (12) pay a \$50 fine and surcharges.

SENTENCE: (1) Supervised probation for up to two years; (2) serve 10 days in the Washington County Jail, with credit for ten days served; (3) pay \$229 in restitution; (4) have no indirect contact with the victim; (5) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare; (6) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with probation; (7) cooperate with the transfer of probation to her county of residence; (8) complete a high school equivalency, and (9) pay a \$50 fine and surcharges.

SENTENCE: Defendant committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for a period of 18 months under a stay of execution and placed on probation for a period of 5 years subject to the following: 1) Serve 180 days in the Washington County Jail, 2) Pay a fine in the amount of \$50, 3) Have no contact with the victim, 4) Complete a full length Domestic Abuse Treatment Program at Human Services, Inc. or an equivalent, 5) Abstain from all mood altering chemicals including alcohol, 6) Be subject to random testing, 7) Seek and maintain gainful employment, 8) Remain law abiding, 9) Follow all the standard conditions of the Intensive Supervision Unit if a resident of Washington County, 10) Cooperate with the transfer of probation to county of residence.

SENTENCE: Defendant committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for a period of 21 months under a stay of execution and placed on probation for a period of 5 years subject to the following: 1) Serve 180 days in the Washington County Jail, 2) Pay a fine in the amount of \$50, 3) Have no contact with the victim, 4) Complete a full length Domestic Abuse Treatment Program at Human Services, Inc. or an equivalent, 5) Abstain from all mood altering chemicals including alcohol, 6) Be subject to random testing, 7) Seek and maintain gainful employment, 8) Remain law abiding, 9) Follow all the standard conditions of the Intensive Supervision Unit if a resident of Washington County, 10) Cooperate with the transfer of probation to county of residence.

Time to be served on the in-custody Sentence to Service if qualified/criteria waived; 2) Complete the Repeat Offender DWI Program, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 3) Pursuant to §169A.277 the defendant is required to serve 30 days of Electronic Home Alcohol Monitoring per year of each year of supervision; 4) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation within 30 days of sentencing and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 5) Complete an evaluation for Driving With Care Skills and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 6) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and

submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 7) Attend AA meetings one time per week for 12 months and provide verification; 8) Attend a MADD Victim Impact Panel and provide verification unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 9) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; and 10) Pursuant to §609.117, provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: Defendant was sentenced under a stay of execution and placed on probation for a period of 5 years subject to the following conditions: 1) Serve 100 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 15 days served on any service, in-custody work release or in or out-of-custody Sentence to Service, 2) Restitution in the amount of \$2,034.47 to the victim joint and several with co-defendant, 3) Complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming and follow recommendations, 4) Complete the Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual Program, 5) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation and 6) Pay a fine in the amount of \$100.
