SENTENCE: Probation for 5 years on the following conditions: 1) serve 30 days in jail with credit for 2 days served, to be served on in-custody Sentence to Service if qualified/criteria waived; 2) pay \$50 fine plus surcharges; 3) restitution ordered; 4) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at own expense; 5) seek and maintain gainful employment or schooling and provide verification; 6) no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 7) cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his County/State of residence; 8) provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

The court allowed 1 day's wages for the victim's wife. 4) Successfully complete anger management and anger management evaluation and follow any recommendations. 5) Obtain a psychological evaluation and follow all recommendations. 6) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random urinalysis or breathalyzers at his own expense. 7) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation. 8) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county of residence and participate in the intensive supervision program if defendant is a Washington County resident.
