SENTENCE: 24 months in prison and pay a \$50 fine.

SENTENCE: Court stayed imposition of sentence and placed defendant on probation for 4 years on following conditions: Follow rules of probation, stay law abiding, pay restitution \$6,675.31, to ProSource, monthly payment to be set up through probation, serve 10 days out-of-custody Sentence to Serve, DNA sample, fine of \$50 plus surcharges, law library fee waived.

On CT II: The Court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for a period of 1 year and 1 day concurrent with CT I, consecutive to his current prison sentence. On CT II, defendant shall serve 8 months in prison and 4 months on supervised release.
