SENTENCE: Count I-Burglary 3rd Degree - The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 21 months, execution of sentence stayed and defendant placed on probation for a period of 5 years on the following conditions: \$200 fine plus fees to cover all four counts, serve 210 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 210 days served, pay restitution of \$29.50 and \$1,605 to victims, abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random testing, successfully complete the Offender Recovery Program, have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation and provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. Count II-Burglary 3rd Degree - The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 24 months with execution stayed and defendant placed on probation for 5 years with conditions of restitution as noted in Count I and provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. Count III-Burglary 3rd Degree - Defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 27 months with execution of sentence stayed and defendant placed on probation or 5 years under same conditions outlined in Count II. Count IV-Burglary 3rd Degree - Defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 30 months with execution of sentence stayed and defendant placed on probation for 5 years under conditions outlined in Count II.

(3) Complete all mental health programming, including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional. (4) Complete the Minnesota Teen Challenge 12-15 month in-patient residential treatment program and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans. (5) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at his own expense. (6) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation. (7) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. (8) Participate in the Washington County Intensive Supervision Program upon release from Minnesota Teen Challenge and if the defendant establishes residence in Washington County. (4) Complete the Minnesota Teen Challenge 12 - 15 month inpatient residential treatment program and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans. (5) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing at his own expense. (6) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. (7) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. (8) Pay restitution; (9) Participate in the Washington County Intensive Supervision Program upon release from Minnesota Teen Challenge and if defendant establishes residence in Washington County. (10) Pay a \$50 fine.
