CONVICTION: Theft Exercising Temporary Control

SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 21 months. Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for 10 years with the following conditions: 1) serve 180 days with credit for time served; 2) pay \$50 fine plus surcharge; 3) no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding; 4) enter and complete the Teen Challenge Program; 5) no use, random testing; 6) restitution of \$1,173.85 to Auto Owners Insurance and \$1,000 to Auto Kraft Unlimited; 7) provide a DNA sample; 8) cooperate with transfer of probation to county of residence.

Time may be served on in-custody Sentence to Service, criteria waived; 2) Pay \$50 fine; 3) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at own expense; 4) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation within 30 days and follow all recommendations; 5) Seek and maintain gainful employment and/or education; 6) Obtain GED and provide verification; 7) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation.

He is to complete an anger management evaluation and follow the recommendations, and he is to provide a DNA sample.

The time may be served on Huber Work Release and the defendant may serve the time on consecutive Friday through Monday dates. 2) Pay a fine of \$300 plus surcharges. 3) Pay restitution in the amount of \$345.00 to victim through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the probation officer. 4) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 5) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis
