SENTENCE: Court stayed adjudication of sentence and placed defendant on probation for 5 years on following conditions: 1) Serve 3 days in jail with credit for 3 days served. 2) Pay \$500 fine plus surcharges. 3) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at own expense. 4) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation.
