DEFENDANT: Paul Isaac Aherns

CONVICTION: 5th Degree Controlled Substance Crime
SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for a period of 15 months. Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for 10 years with the following conditions: 1) serve 232 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 181 days served; 2) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans; 3) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing; 4) seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification; 5) cooperate with the transfer of supervision to his county of residence; 6) provide a DNA sample; 7) pay a \$50 fine.

SENTENCE: Court stayed imposition of sentence and placed defendant on probation for 5 years on the following conditions: 1) Defendant ordered to serve 60 days in the Washington County Jail, with credit for 2 days, on any alternative deemed appropriate by the Court and criteria waived, including Electronic Home Monitoring. 2) Have no contact with minors until approved by a therapist trained in the evaluation and treatment of sexual offenders and his supervising probation officer. 3) Enter and complete sex offender treatment. Treatment provider must be approved by supervising probation officer. 4) Participate and pay for any polygraph testing per the instructions of the supervising probation officer or treatment provider. 5) Do not use any devices, (computers, cell phones, etc.) with Internet access until approved by treatment provider and his supervising probation officer. Defendant must comply with random computer searches and/or monitoring to verify compliance. 6) Follow all the standard conditions of the Washington County Sex Offender Unit at the direction of the supervising probation officer. 7) Have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 8) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his County of residence. 9) Register as a predatory offender. 10) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. Court ordered defendant to pay a \$1,000 fine plus fees

Defendant ordered to obtain a chemical dependency evaluation within 15 days following any positive or missed test and follow all recommendations; 3) Complete an evaluation for cognitive skills programming in his county of residence, if available, and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 4) Seek and maintain gainful employment and/or education and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; 5) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 6) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county of residence; 7) Pursuant to §609.117 defendant ordered to provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis; and 8) \$50.00 fine.

Chemical dependency evaluation within 15 days following any positive or missed test and follow recommendations; 4) Complete evaluation for cognitive skills programming and follow recommendations; 5) Maintain gainful employment and/or education and provide verification; 6) No same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with standard conditions of probation; 7) Cooperate with transfer of supervision; and 8) Biological specimen for DNA analysis.

recommendations; complete an anger management and/or domestic abuse treatment program; complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations; abstain for the use of all mood altering chemicals including alcohol and submit to random testing; seek and maintain gainful employment; follow all the standard conditions of the Intensive Supervision Unit; have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; complete the Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual Program; and provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.
