DEFENDANT: Sonya Swearingen Adler
DOB: 5/21/1966
CITY/RESIDENCE: St. Paul, MN
AGENCY: Oakdale Police Department
CONVICTION: Issue Dishonored Check
SENTENCE: The defendant was sentenced under a stay of execution and placed on probation for a period of 3 years subject to the following conditions: 1) Serve 88 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 88 days served, 2) Complete all mental health programming, including taking all prescribed medication, 3) Complete a Cognitive Skills Intake, 4) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation, 5) Cooperate with transfer of probation to county of residence, 6) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis and 7) Pay a fine in the amount of \$50.

SENTENCE: On the charge of Receiving Stolen Property, the defendant received the following sentence: 21 months in prison, concurrent with the defendant's 88 month Ramsey County sentence and the sentence imposed in Washington County file number 82-CR-09-4896 (Aiding and Abetting Burglary in the 2nd Degree); he was given credit for 329 days already served; he was ordered to pay restitution to the victim in the amount of \$2,450.09; he was also ordered to pay a \$50 fine, which will be deducted from any prison wages.

SENTENCE: The defendant received the following felony sentence: 38 months in prison, concurrent with the defendant's Ramsey County 88 month prison sentence, and the prison sentence imposed in Washington County file number 82-CR-09-1832 (Receiving Stolen Property); the defendant was given credit for 329 days served; he is ordered to pay a \$50 fine, which will be deducted from any prison earnings; he was also ordered to pay restitution to the victim in the amount of \$2,450.09, joint and several with the co-defendant.

SENTENCE: The defendant was sentenced under a stay of imposition and placed on probation for a period of 5 years subject to the following conditions: 1) Serve 52 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 52 days, 2) Successfully complete the Offender Recovery Program, 3) Pay restitution in the amount of \$1,062.12 to Great Lakes Management Company, 4) Complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills, 5) Complete the Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual program, 6) Complete a psychological evaluation, 7) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing, 8) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation, and 9) Pay a fine in the amount of \$50.

SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 48 months. Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for 20 years with the following conditions: 1) 90 days on in-custody Sentence to Service, he was taken into custody today; 2) have no contact with the victims; 3) pay a \$400 fine; 4) complete intake for cognitive skills programming and follow the recommendations; 5) complete a chemical dependency evaluation; if defendant has any positive urinalysis, he is to then follow the recommendations from that evaluation including aftercare; 4) abstain from the use of mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, submit to random testing and get a baseline urinalysis today; 6) no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding; 7) he is to not possess any weapons during his probation and abide by State and Federal rules after discharge; 8) complete the RUDI (Resources for the Unemployed and Determined Individual) Program; 9) follow the standard conditions of the Intensive Supervision Unit; 10) provide a DNA sample.

SENTENCE: Court stayed imposition of sentence and placed defendant on probation for 5 years on following conditions: 1) Serve 63 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 63 days served. 2) Have no direct or indirect contact with the victim, his family, residence and place of employment. 3) Complete a full-length domestic abuse treatment program; defendant to schedule a program intake with Human Services, Inc. within 30 days and follow all recommendations unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. If program defendant completed at Maghakian House is sufficient, probation can waive this recommendation. Defendant attended an anger management program. Court recognized that is different than Domestic Abuse treatment. 4) Complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 5) Abstain from the use of all mood altering chemicals, unless prescriptions, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 6) Obtain all benzodiazepines, opiates, or muscle relaxers through one prescribing qualified doctor, as approved by Washington County Community Corrections, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 7) Obtain a psychiatrist for mental health medications and a therapist through the same agency or building for direct correspondence regarding defendant to coordinate care and medications, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 8) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 9) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. 10) Defendant ordered to pay a \$50 fine plus fees.
