CONVICTION: 2nd Degree DWI
SENTENCE: \$3000 fine and 365 days in jail with \$2600 and 245 days suspended for 4 years, follow all rules of probation, follow all recommendations from her treatment, 30 days in jail with credit for 16 days towards 30, 90 days to be done on Electronic Home Monitoring.

CONVICTION: Assault in the 4th Degree-Correctional Employees
SENTENCE: The Court sentenced the defendant to one year and one day commitment to the Commissioner of Corrections consecutive to the sentence he is presently serving, \$50 fine and DNA sample.

SENTENCE: Receiving Stolen Property charge - Court stayed imposition of sentence and placed defendant on probation for up to 20 years on following conditions: 1) Serve 180 days in jail with credit for 10 days served. Time to be served on any in-custody alternative, concurrent to 5th Degree Drugs charge. 2) Pay \$50 fine plus surcharges. 3) Pay restitution of \$500, if ordered by the Court. 4) Have no direct or indirect contact with any victims involved in the current offense. 5) Complete inpatient/outpatient chemical dependency treatment. 6) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at own expense. 7) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 8) Cooperate with the transfer of supervision to his County/State of residence. 9) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. On 5th Degree Drugs charge - Court stayed the adjudication of sentence and placed defendant on probation for 5 years on following conditions: Same conditions as Receiving Stolen Property charge

above.

SENTENCE: Issued a stay of imposition of sentence and 5 years probation on following conditions: 1) Serve 30 days in jail with credit for 20 days served. 2) Pay \$500 fine plus surcharges. 3) No direct or indirect contact with any juvenile female under the age of 16. 4) Complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming and follow all recommendations. 5) Complete a mental health evaluation and follow all recommendations. 6) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at own expense. 7) Attend AA/NA meetings 1 time per week for 12 months. 8) No same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 9) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: Court sentenced the defendant to 44 months commitment to the Commissioner of Corrections, concurrent with the sentence he is presently doing with credit back to October 23, 2007. Restitution is left open for 30 days; DNA sample and \$50 fine.

SENTENCE: Defendant placed on probation for five years under the following conditions: (1) serve 20 days in jail, which may be served on out-of-custody Sentence to Service; (2) pay a fine of \$200 plus surcharges; (3) meet and cooperate with MN Department of Revenue within 15 days of sentencing and follow all requirements, including audits; restitution investigation to remain open for 60 days; (4) complete a Rule 82 gambling assessment and follow recommendations; (5) seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to supervising probation officer; (6) have no same

or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; (7) cooperate with the transfer of his probation to his county of residence, and (8) provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: The court committed the defendant to the Commissioner of Corrections for 98 months and stayed the execution of sentence and placed defendant on probation for 25 years under the following conditions: (1) 365 days in jail with credit for 163 days; defendant may be released directly to Teen Challenge or Salvation Army program if a bed becomes available, and any jail time not served will be rescheduled to after the defendant completes the program. (2) Pay a \$50 fine plus surcharges. (3) Seek and maintain gainful employment. (4) Complete long-term chemical dependence treatment and all recommended aftercare, including halfway house, if deemed appropriate. (5) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing. (6) Provide biological specimen. (7) Cooperate with transfer of supervision to his county of residence. (8) Have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding and comply with all standard conditions of felony probation. Other counts were dismissed.
