SENTENCE: Defendant was committed to the commissioner of Corrections for a period of 17 months, under a stay of execution of sentence. The defendant was placed on probation under the supervision of Washington County Community Corrections for a period not to exceed 5 years on the following conditions: 1) serve no additional time in the Washington County Jail with credit for 259 days served in Minnesota; 2) pay a fine in the amount of \$50.00, plus surcharges on a schedule to be established by Court Administration within 6 months; 3) pay restitution in the amount of \$2,245.39 to Miller Brothers Auto Repair through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer; 4) complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 5) complete all mental health programming; 6) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary; 7) seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation officer; 8) Pursuant to §609.117, Defendant was ordered to provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis; 9) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; and 10) cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his County/State residence.
