DEFENDANT: Robin Linda Hanly

CONVICTION: Issue Dishonored Check

SENTENCE: Placed on probation for 5 years on the following special conditions: 1) serve 30 days in jail with credit for 3 days served, to be served on Home Detention; 2) pay \$200 fine plus surcharges; 3) restitution ordered; 4) complete all mental health programming/including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional; 5) no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 6) cooperate with the transfer of supervision to County/State of residence; 7) provide a DNA sample per statute.

SENTENCE: On Count 2: Felony Criminal Vehicular Operation, the defendant was sentenced under a stay of imposition and placed on probation for a period of 3 years subject to the following conditions: serve 45 days in the Washington County Jail, serving 15 days now and attend a Review Hearing in 6 months to address the remainder, pay a fine in the amount of \$500 plus surcharges, perform 80 hours of Community Work Service, pay restitution in the amount of \$1,040 to first victims, restitution to be left open for future medical bills,

restitution to second victim is left open for 30 days, have no direct contact with the victims, complete Victim/Offender Conferencing, complete all mental health programming, abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, submit to random testing, attend AA three times per week for 12 months, have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, cooperate with the standard conditions of probation, and provide a biological specimen for the purposes of DNA analysis. On Count 5: Gross Misdemeanor Criminal Vehicular Operation, the defendant was sentenced to a \$3,000 fine and 365 days with \$2,950 of the fine and 320 days stayed, to run concurrent to Count 2 and with all the same conditions as Count 2.
