CONVICTION: Aiding and Abetting Theft

SENTENCE: 21 months in prison, execution stayed for five years on the following conditions: (1) supervised probation for up to five years; (2) pay a \$50 fine and surcharges within 90 days; (3) serve 175 days in jail, credit 175 days served; (4) remain law abiding, keep the peace and be of good behavior.

SENTENCE: (1) Supervised probation for up to five years; (2) serve 60 days in the Washington County Jail, with credit for five days served, and this jail sentence to run concurrently with the defendant's Hennepin County sentence; (3) pay restitution to Oakdale HomeGoods Store in the amount of \$830.62 on a schedule to be determined by the supervising probation agent; (4) have no direct or indirect contact with any HomeGoods store; (5) commit no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with the standard conditions of probation; (6) cooperate with the transfer of supervision to the defendant's county of residence (Ramsey County); (7) complete a Rule 82 gambling assessment within 30 days, and (8) pay a \$100 fine and surcharges within 12 months.

SENTENCE: The Court stayed the imposition of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for 7 years under the following conditions: 1) Serve 60 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 2 days served; time to be served 30 days out-of-custody Sentence to Service and 30 days (240 hours) Community Work Service. 2) Complete all mental health programming recommended by Human Services, Inc., including taking all prescribed medication at the direction of the mental health professional, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 3) No same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all of the standard conditions of probation; 4) Cooperate with the transfer of her supervision to her County/State of residence. 5) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. 6) No contact with Keith Washington or any inmate at DOC-Stillwater.
