DEFENDANT: Nathan John Ellering
DOB: 6/25/1979
CITY/RESIDENCE: St. Paul, MN
AGENCY: Oakdale Police Department
CONVICTION: I: Terroristic Threats; II: Violation of Order for Protection
SENTENCE: On Count I: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 21 months under a stay of execution and placed on probation for a period of 5 years subject to the following conditions: credit for 124 actual days already served, \$50 fine, comply with Order for Protection, complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow recommendations, complete a psychological evaluation and follow recommendations, abstain from all mood altering chemicals including alcohol, be subject to random testing, seek and maintain gainful employment, remain law abiding and provide a DNA sample. On Count II: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 21 months, probation 5 years, all other conditions same as Count I, sentence to run concurrent to Count I

SENTENCE: Imposition of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for five years with the following conditions: 1) 27 days jail with credit for 27 days served; 2) \$50 fine; 3) complete mental health programming; 4) abstain from the use of chemicals, including alcohol, random testing; 5) attend AA twice per week for two years; 6) seek and maintain gainful employment; 7) remain law abiding; 8) provide a DNA sample.

SENTENCE: On the charge of offering a forged check, the defendant received the following felony sentence: One year and one day in prison, execution stayed for up to five years on the following conditions: 1) Supervised probation for up to five years; 2) Serve 90 days in jail, with credit for 35 days served; the jail time is straight time; 3) Pay a \$50 fine and \$82 in surcharges within six months; 4) Pay \$62 in restitution to victims through Washington County Court Administration, on a schedule to be determined by the supervising probation agent; 5) Sign medical releases of information for release of that information by the treating psychologist and/or psychiatrist; 6) Complete all mental health programming; 7) Obtain a gambling assessment at Washington County Human Services, Inc. and follow all recommendations; 8) Abstain from the use of mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis at his own expense; 9) Seek and maintain gainful employment and provide verification to the supervising probation agent; 10) Have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding, and cooperate with probation; 11) Cooperate with the transfer of supervision to his county of residence, and 12) Provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: The Court stayed the imposition of sentence and placed the defendant on probation for up to five years on the following conditions: 1) Serve 15 days in the Washington County Jail on work release, in-custody Sentence to Service or out-of-custody Sentence to Service; 2) Pay a fine of \$200.00 plus surcharge; 3) Complete Victim Offender Conferencing unless supervising probation officer deems unnecessary; 4) Complete evaluation for cognitive skills and follow recommendations; 5) Complete all mental health programming; 6) Complete an updated chemical dependency and follow recommendations; 7) Abstain and be subject to random testing; 8) Attend AA/NA one time per week for three months and provide verification; 9) No same or similar offenses and be law abiding; 10) Pursuant to §609.177 provide biological specimen. Restitution in the amount of \$520.00 to victim.

SENTENCE: (1) Supervised probation for 20 years; (2) serve 365 days in jail, with credit for 201 days served; (3) pay a \$100 fine plus surcharges; (4) pay restitution to victim; restitution left open for 30 days; (5) Victim Offender Conferencing, if okay with probation; (6) take prescribed medication; (7) abstain from drugs, unless prescribed medication, and (8) provide a DNA sample.

SENTENCE: A 5 year stay of imposition of sentence on the following conditions: 1) Supervised probation for up to five years; 2) Serve 23 days in jail with credit for two days served, and time may be served on the out-of-custody Sentence to Service program; 3) Pay a \$300 fine and surcharges on a schedule to be determined by Court Administration; 4) Pay \$1,081.60 to Target Corporation through Washington County Court Administration, on a schedule to be determined by the supervising probation agent; 5) Complete all mental health programming; 6) Abstain from the use of mood altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis at her own expense; 7) Complete the 20-session women's aftercare group at Hudson Hospital Programs for Change and provide verification to the supervising probation agent; 8) Commit no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with probation; 9) Cooperate with the transfer of supervision to Wisconsin, and 10) Provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis.

SENTENCE: Commit to the Commissioner of Corrections for 26 months concurrent to the Ramsey County related prison sentence he is currently serving. Defendant agrees to pay restitution on both counts of \$8,800 and \$600 to each victim. The court waived the fine and surcharge, finding the defendant indigent, and ordered that he provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis if he has not already done so.

SENTENCE: The defendant was committed to the Commissioner of Corrections for 36 months. Execution of sentence was stayed and the defendant was placed on probation for seven years with the following conditions: 1) serve 180 days jail with credit for 125 days served; 2) pay a fine of \$50 plus surcharges; 3) serve 30 days of Electronic Home Monitoring for each year of probation in addition to jail time; 4) complete New Choices for Recovery Program and follow all recommendations, including aftercare; 5) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing; 6) attend AA/NA two times per week for six months and provide verification; 7) attend a MADD Victim Impact Panel, unless supervising probation agent deems it unnecessary; 8) seek and maintain gainful employment or attend schooling and provide verification to supervising probation agent; 9)

complete a Level II Driving With Care education program unless deemed unnecessary by supervising probation agent; 10) have no same or similar offenses, remain law abiding and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation; 11) cooperate with the transfer of probation to county of residence; 12) provide a DNA sample.
