DEFENDANT: Daniel David Vansteenburgh  
DOB: 4/4/1970  
CITY/RESIDENCE: Woodbury, MN  
AGENCY: Woodbury Police Department  
CONVICTION: Disorderly Conduct  
SENTENCE: The defendant was placed on probation for a period of 1 year subject to the following conditions: 1) Serve 1 day in the Washington County Jail with credit for 1 day served, 2) Have no direct or indirect contact with the victim or her place of residence, 3) Ordered not to visit massage business, 4) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation and 5) Pay a fine in the amount of \$1,000.

SENTENCE: Count I - 5th Degree Controlled Substance: Imposition of sentence was stayed for five years with the following conditions: 1) serve 60 days in the Washington County Jail with credit for 13 days served, time may be served on the in-custody Sentence to Service program; 2) complete a psychological evaluation and follow all recommendations; 3) complete a chemical dependency evaluation and follow all recommendations, including aftercare plans; 4) abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random testing; 5) have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation; 6) cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his county/state of residence; 7) provide a specimen for purposes of DNA analysis; 8) pay a \$50 fine plus surcharges.

Count II - Gross Misdemeanor DWI: The defendant was ordered to pay a \$3,000 fine and serve 365 days in jail. \$2,950 of the fine and 305 days of the jail time were suspended and the defendant was placed on probation for three years under the same conditions as for Count I. He was also ordered to attend a MADD Victim Impact Panel within 120 days and participate in the Repeat Offender Program.

Time may be served on out-of-custody Sentence to Service, if qualified. 2) Pay restitution in the amount of \$1,998.88 to Bremer Bank through Washington County Court Administration on a schedule to be established by the supervising probation officer. 3) Sign medical releases for probation. 4) Complete a Cognitive Skills Programming Intake in her county of residence, if available, and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 5) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 6)

Cooperate with the transfer of her supervision to her county of residence. 7) Provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. 8) Pay a \$50 fine plus fees.
