

General Information for Washington County Campgrounds

For your enjoyment (and that of other campers), we ask you to abide by the following:

- Campers under 18 must be accompanied by parent or guardian
- One Camping unit per site
- One car/vehicle is allowed per site
- Additional vehicles must park in the guest parking areas and not on the grass
- All vehicles entering the park require vehicle permits
- All vehicles, including tent trailers, must be parked on the pads
- Boat trailers may be parked on the grass
- All vehicles at the site must be completely off the road
- Prior approval of campground staff must be obtained before changing sites
- Checkout time is 1:00 p.m.
- You must be off your site by this time
- Re-registration must be by 11:00 a.m. if you wish to stay additional nights
- You must change sites every seven days
- Quiet hours: 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- Alcoholic beverages, including 3.2 beer are prohibited
- Campers are responsible to furnish their own refuse bags and to dispose of all refuse in the containers located at the campground entrance
- Fires in fire rings or self-contained grills only
- **No pets allowed**
- A swimming beach is available Memorial Day Weekend through Labor Day
- All terrain vehicles (ATV) cannot be used in the park
- Cutting of park trees (dead or alive) and gathering firewood is prohibited. Firewood can be purchased at the park office.
- Management reserves the right to ask any camper to leave the campground
- Park Ordinance enforced by Washington County Sheriff's Department
