CONVICTION: Predatory Offender Registration Violation
SENTENCE: 365 days with 365 days stayed and \$3,000 fine with \$2,500 stayed to Court for 5 years on following conditions: 1) Pay \$200 fine plus fees. 2) No same or similar offenses and remain law abiding. Defendant may reside in Memphis, TN; follow registration requirements.

Time may be served on any appropriate jail alternative combination such as work release, Electronic Home Monitoring, or Sentence to Service programs (permitting Defendant to remain employed). 2) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense. 3) Comply with the chemical dependency and mental health programming plan as developed by AA Alternative, Inc. and in which program Defendant currently participates. 4) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all standard conditions of probation. 5) Complete 50 hours of Community Work Service within 6 months. However, if he enters the Repeat Offenders Program in Anoka County by then he does not have to report to jail. If defendant successfully completes the program he can serve time on staggered sentencing. If he did not complete the Repeat Offenders Program, defendant will have to turn self in to serve balance of year. 2) Complete the Repeat Offender DWI Program, if available in County of residence, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 3) Serve 30 days on Electric Home Alcohol Monitoring per year for each year of probation supervision. 4) Complete an evaluation for Cognitive Skills Programming if available in County of residence and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 5) Complete an evaluation for Driving With Care Skills and follow all recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems in unnecessary. 6) Complete outpatient chemical dependency treatment at Grace Counseling Services and follow all aftercare recommendations, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 7) Abstain from the use of all mood-altering

chemicals, including alcohol, and submit to random urinalysis/breathalyzers at his own expense, unless the supervising probation officer deems it unnecessary. 8) Attend AA meetings 2 times per week for 12 months and provide verification to the supervising probation officer. 9) Attend a MADD Victim Impact Panel, unless the supervising probation officer deems in unnecessary. 10) Have no same or similar offenses, be law abiding, and cooperate with all the standard conditions of probation. 11) Cooperate with the transfer of his supervision to his County/State of residence. 12) provide a biological specimen for purposes of DNA analysis. 13) Ordered to complete 50 hours of Community Work Service within a year in lieu of ordering fine.
