What is the Collectors' Corner Neighborhood Trading Post?

At the Collectors' Corner Satellite, kids of all ages can bring in a natural object (or a journal entry, photograph, rubbings or drawings of that object) and share their knowledge about the item with Collectors' Corner volunteers. The more a trader knows about the object, the more points they will earn. With the points earned, the trader will be able to trade what they discussed for another item at the trading post.
