

Very Small Quantity Generator Collection Program



Who can participate?

- Businesses from Washington County only that generate less than 220 pounds of hazardous waste per month.
- SQG and LQGs not eligible

What can I bring?

- Hazardous Waste solvents, cleaners, paints, etc.
- Universal wastes: Batteries, Bulbs, Aerosols
- Used oil and Oil related wastes
- NO infectious waste or Pharmaceuticals. NO electronics or appliances

Where do I go?

- See reverse side for hours and location

How do I pack the waste for transport?

- Waste must be segregated and secure for transport
- MN DOT requirements: www.goo.gl/tdovU

How much does it cost?

- There is a \$15 minimum fee + waste disposal fees
- Upon drop off you will receive an invoice to be paid within 30 days

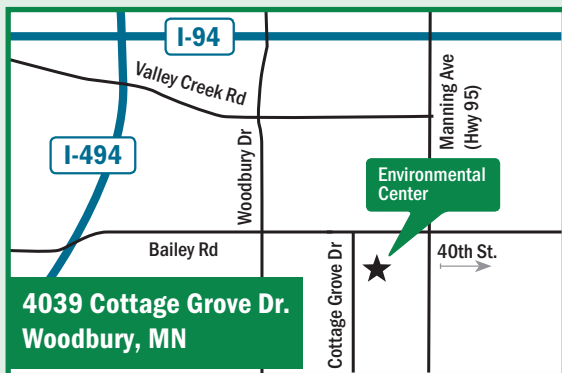


Safe Transporting Guidelines

Safe transport of hazardous materials is important to prevent problems such as chemical reactions and leaks.

1. Select a sealed and leak proof shipping container.
2. Label all containers **not** in the original can or bottle.
3. Segregate incompatibles - examples: don't mix acids and bases, acids and cyanides; or oxidizers and flammables.
4. Secure the load to prevent tipping and rolling
