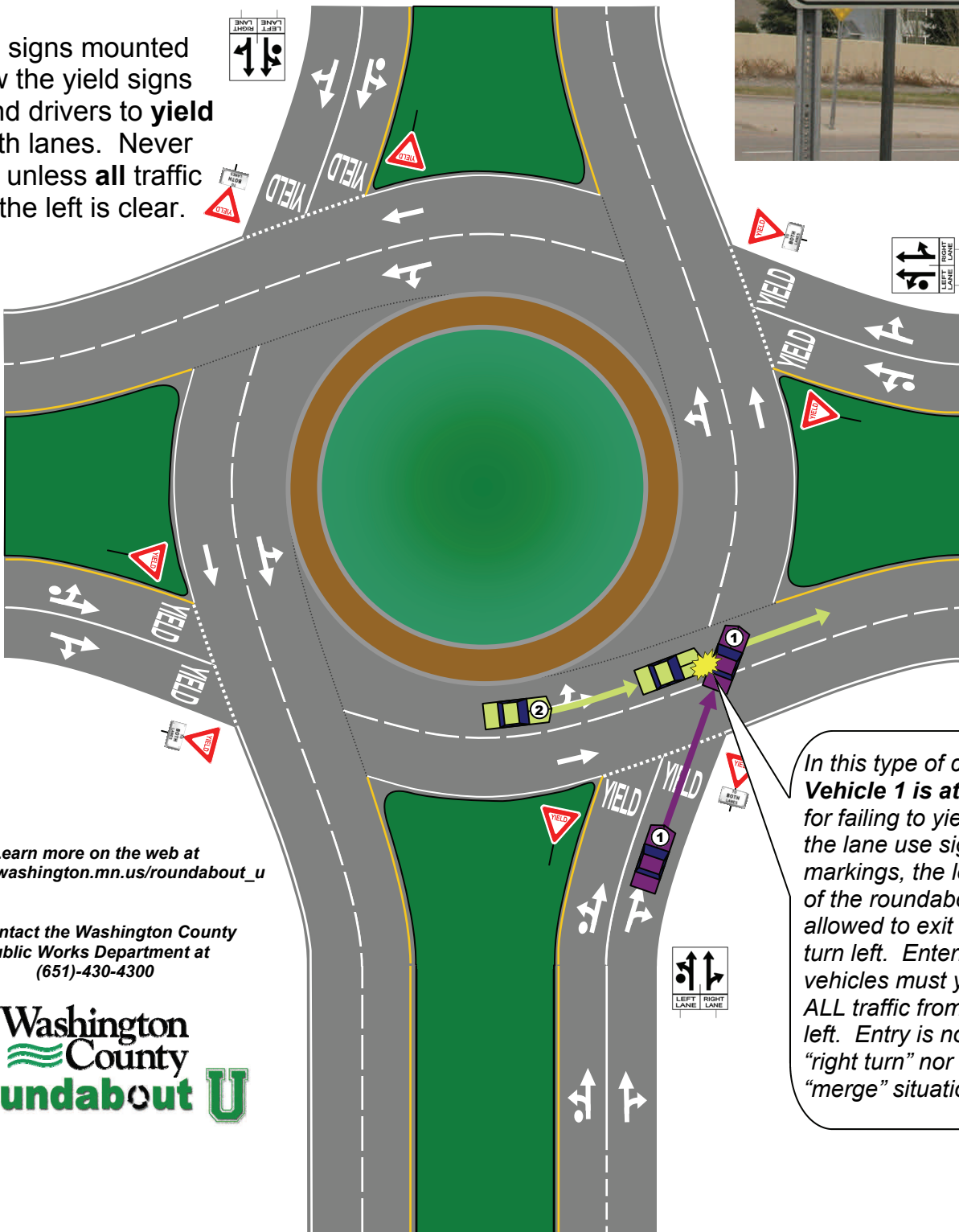


Failure to Yield

Entering a roundabout is similar to an intersection between two one-way roads, where the road from the left continues out of the roundabout and has the right-of-way. Entering drivers must **yield** to cross traffic, waiting until all traffic from the left is clear.

Entering drivers are not permitted to “merge” alongside cross traffic, because both lanes of cross traffic exit the roundabout. Entry is neither a “right turn” nor a “merge”.

Extra signs mounted below the yield signs remind drivers to **yield** to both lanes. Never enter unless **all** traffic from the left is clear.

In this type of crash, **Vehicle 1 is at fault** for failing to yield. Per the lane use signs and markings, the left lane of the roundabout is allowed to exit or to turn left. Entering vehicles must yield to ALL traffic from the left. Entry is not a “right turn” nor a “merge” situation.
