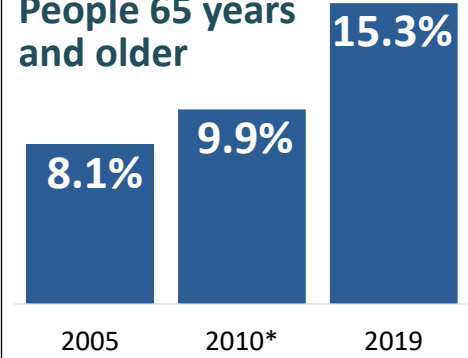

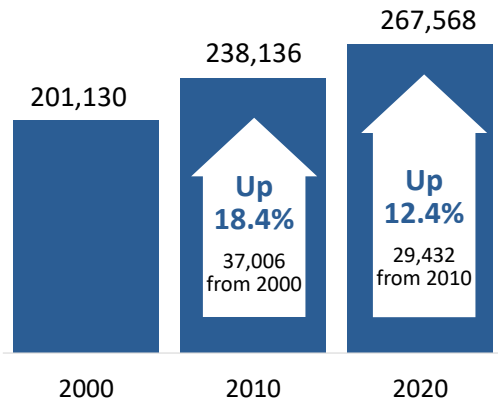

### Percentage of People 65 years and older



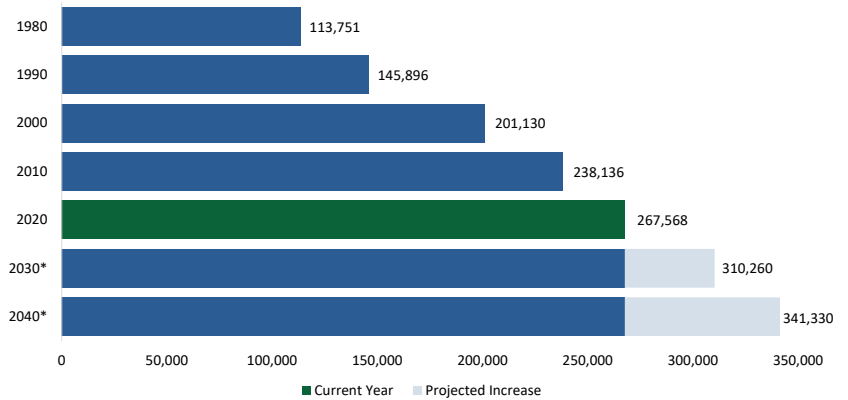

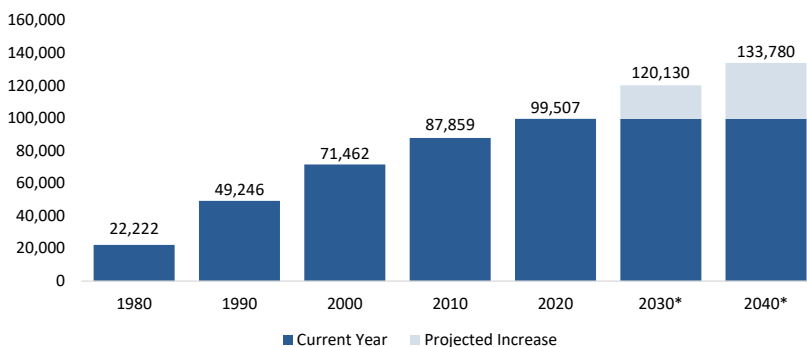
### Population + Projected Increase by Decade

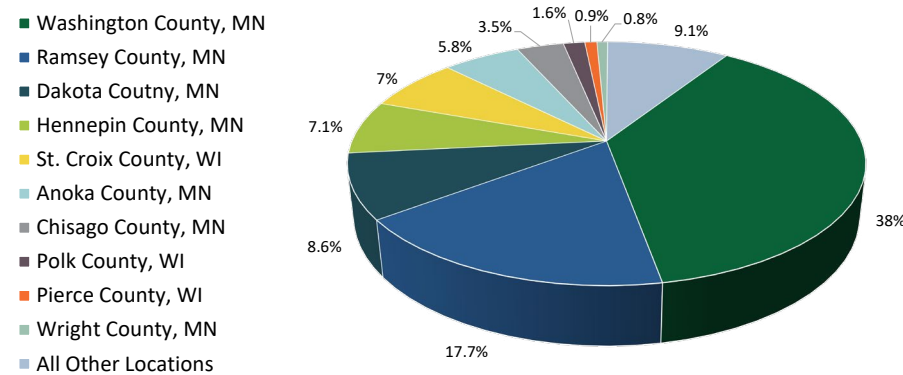

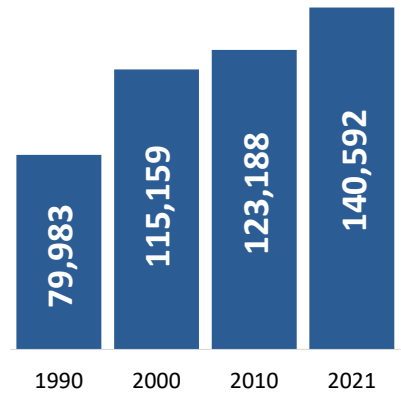

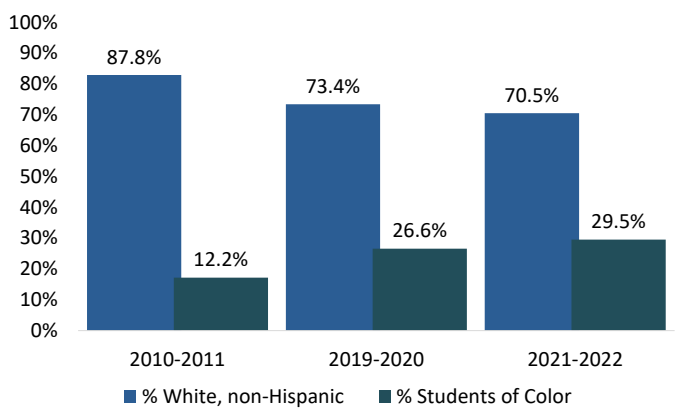
## County Residents Employed

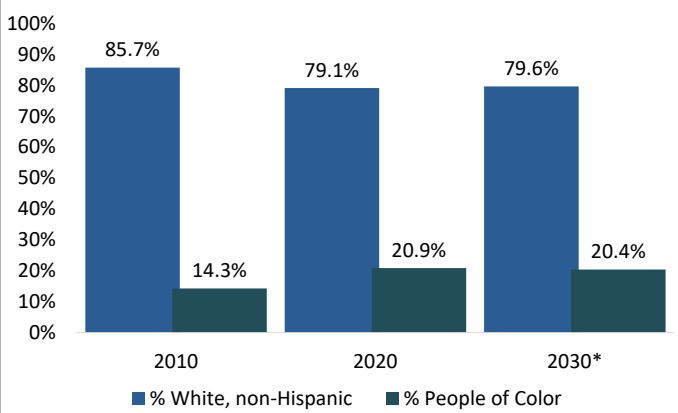

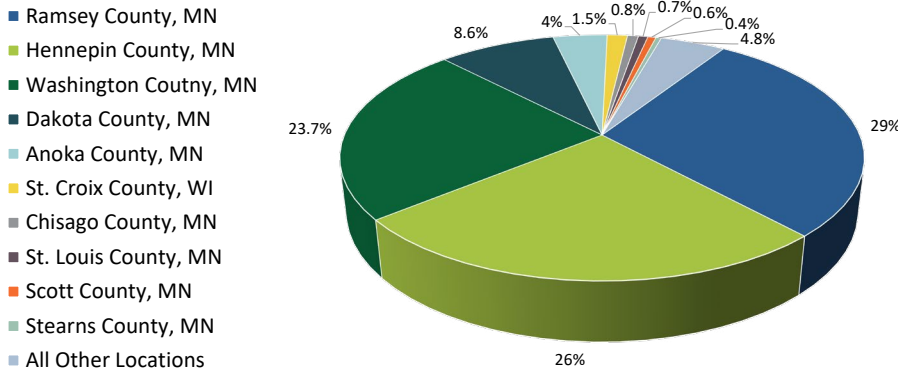

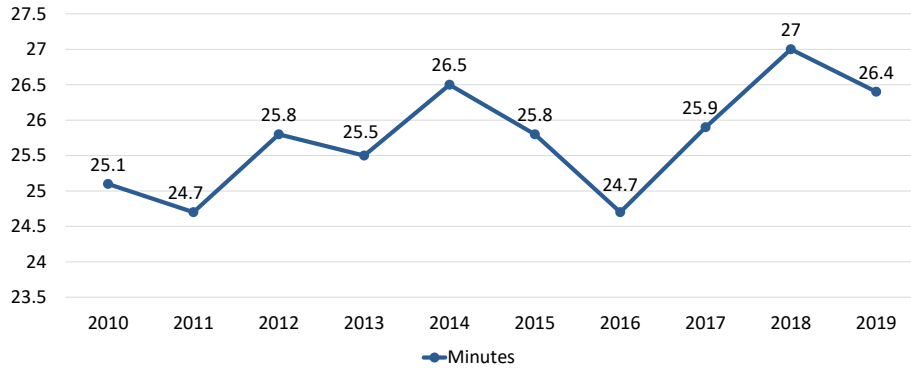
