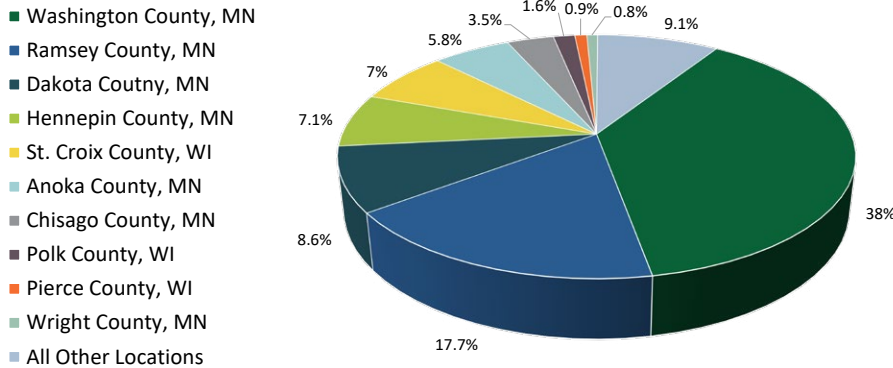

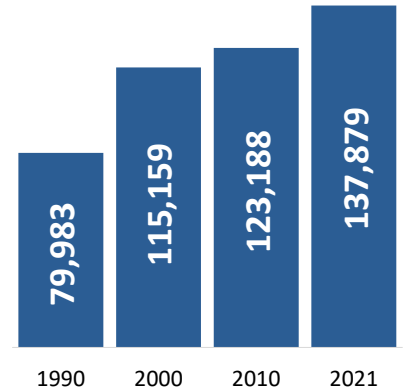

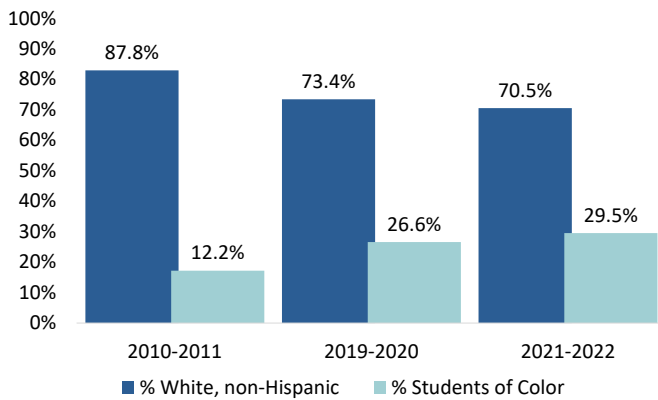
## County Labor Force Employed

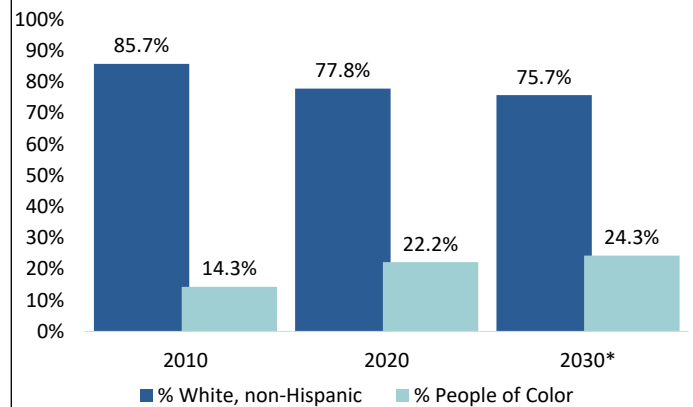

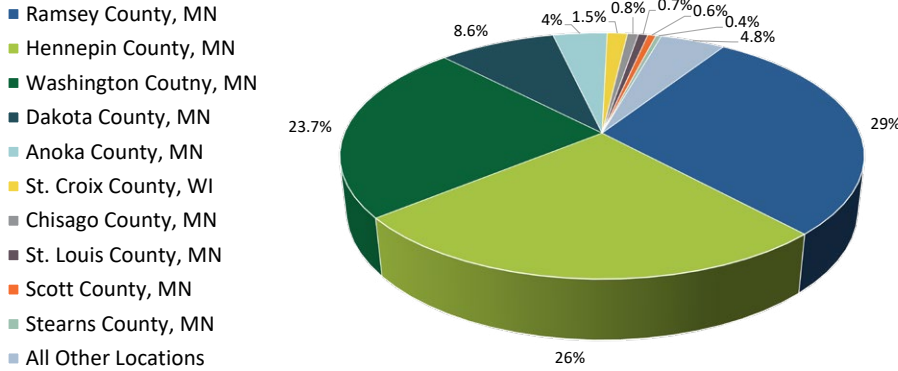

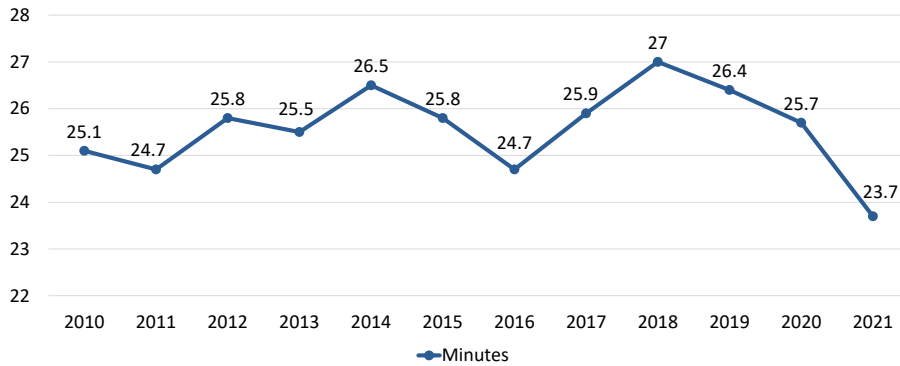
