### Trails

Pine Point Regional Park offers an estimated eight miles of trails for cross country skiing, horseback riding, hiking, and biking.

### Ski Trails

Groomed skate and single track classic ski trails wind through forested areas for a total of 4 miles/6.5 km.

- ❖ The yellow loop is intermediate and rolling.
- ❖ The green loop is easy with two hills.

All skiers ages 16 and older must carry the **MN State Ski Pass** when using Washington County ski trails.

### Multi-Use Trails

#### Purple Bike and Hike

Located east of Norrell Avenue, this trail measures 1.3 miles/2.1 km and travels through open prairie and forested terrain.

### Multi-Use Trails

#### Blue Horse and Hike

Three separate blue trails, totaling 2.9 miles/4.7 km on the west side of the park, allow for horseback riding and hiking.

- ❖ North blue route begins and ends at the parking lot with an outlet at Myeron Road.
- ❖ Southeast blue route winds through the pine trees parallel to Norell Avenue.
- ❖ Central blue route begins and ends on the Gateway trail with views of a wetland.

### Gateway State Trail

- ❖ The Gateway Trail, maintained by the Minnesota DNR, is available for non-motorized winter use.
- ❖ Turf trails parallel to the paved trail are designated for horseback riding and hiking.

### Events & Programs

Visit the Washington County Parks website for information about upcoming park events and programs.

### Facilities

A covered picnic table and portable toilets are available for use in the trailhead parking lot.

### Fees

A Washington County Parks vehicle permit is required on all motorized vehicles.

Permits can be purchased at the **Pay Station** at the entrance to the park. Redeem annual slips in person or by mail at any Washington County Park office during office hours.

Anoka and Carver County Parks vehicle permits are also valid.

### Park Rules & Etiquette

- ❖ Skiing on groomed ski trails only.
- ❖ Dogs are allowed on the multi-use trails only and must be on a 6' leash.
- ❖ Park in the designated parking lot only.
- ❖ Observe directional signs.
- ❖ Alcohol is not allowed.
- ❖ Campfires are not allowed.
- ❖ Warn others when passing.

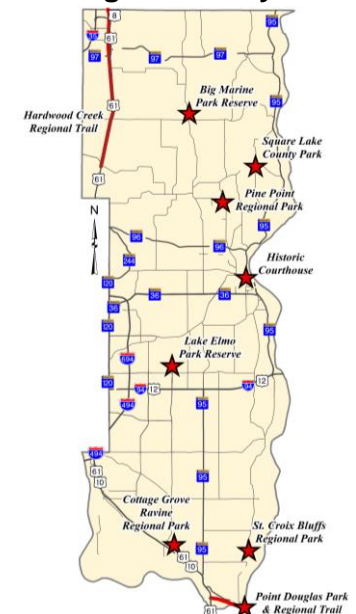

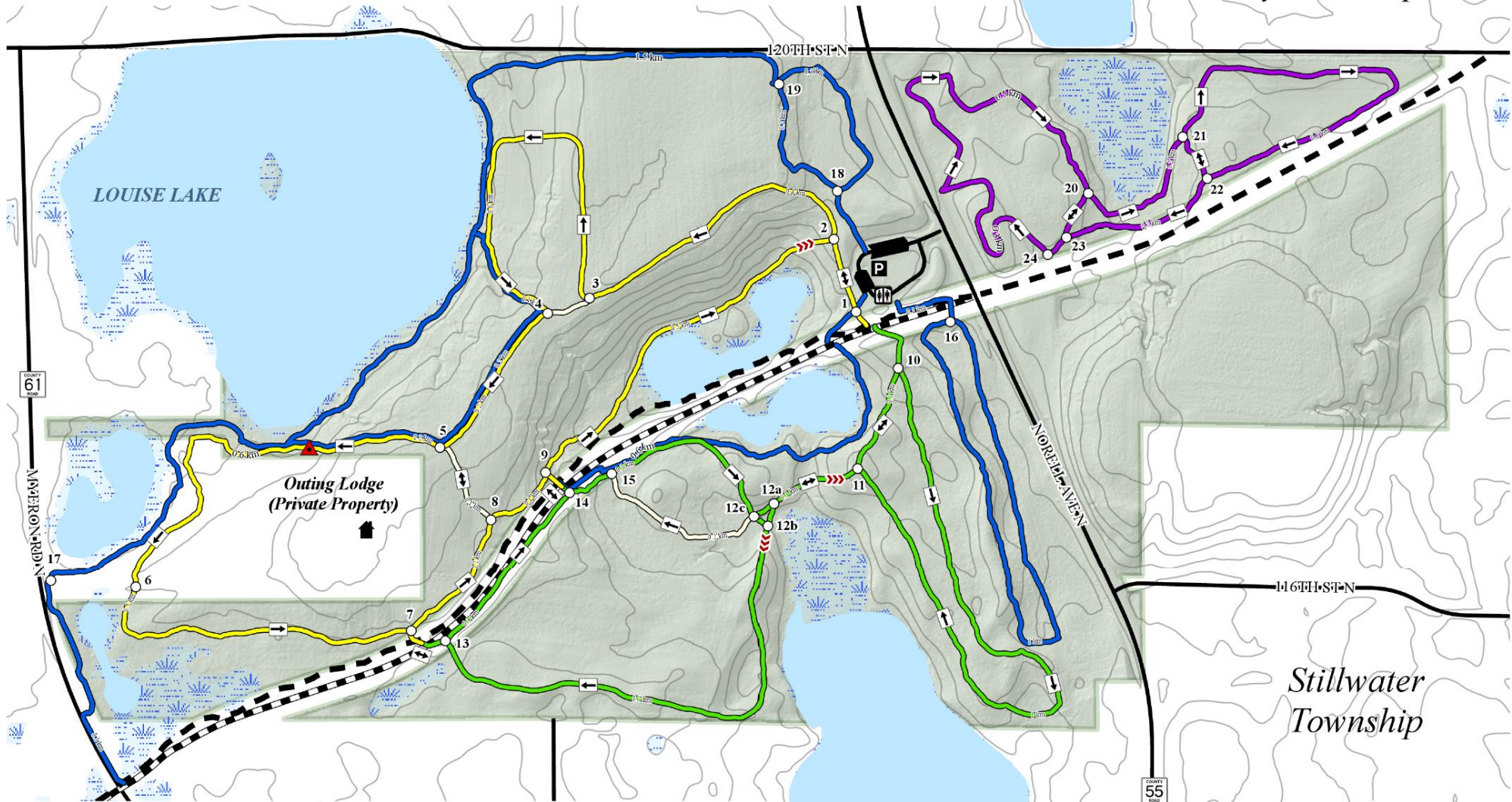
