Hazardous Materials Accepted

Hazardous materials and electronics will be accepted free-of-charge from households only (no businesses). Proof of residency required.

Household Items:

- Mercury thermometers and thermostats
- Fluorescent bulbs (bundled together with rubber bands, no tape)
- Household cleaners
- Sharps, syringes, needles and used epi pens in a sealed, sturdy container
- Computers & monitors
- Peripherals (keyboards, mice, speakers, etc.)
- Printers & fax machines
- TVs, DVD & VCR players
- Cell phones

Document shredding will also be offered. To serve as many people as possible, no more than four boxes per customer will be accepted. Please note that shredding capacity may be reached before the end of the event.



Electronics Accepted

Home Improvement:

- Latex /oil paint & stain
- Paint remover/thinner

Automotive & Recreation:

- Antifreeze
- Used motor oil and filters
- Propane tanks
- Rechargeable batteries

Yard & Garden:

- Insect/roach/ant killer
- Fertilizers/herbicides

NOTE: Please organize your load so all electronics and hazardous materials can be removed first.

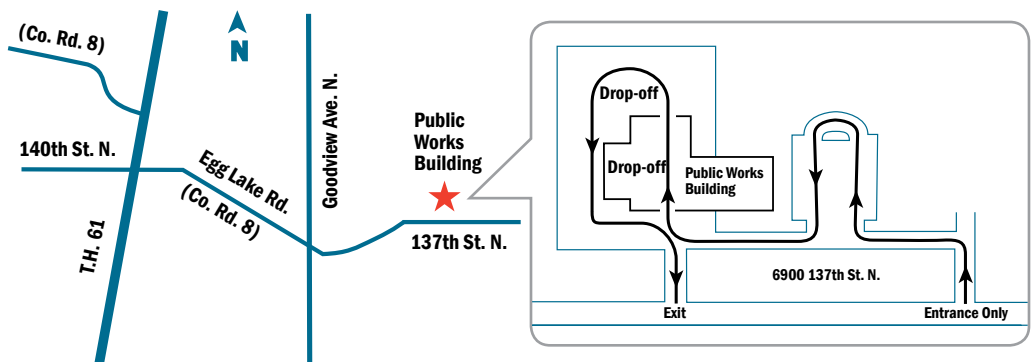
Cash or checks only. Please bring small bills. Please make payable to City of Hugo. (Proportional rates may be applied to partial loads and overloaded trucks)

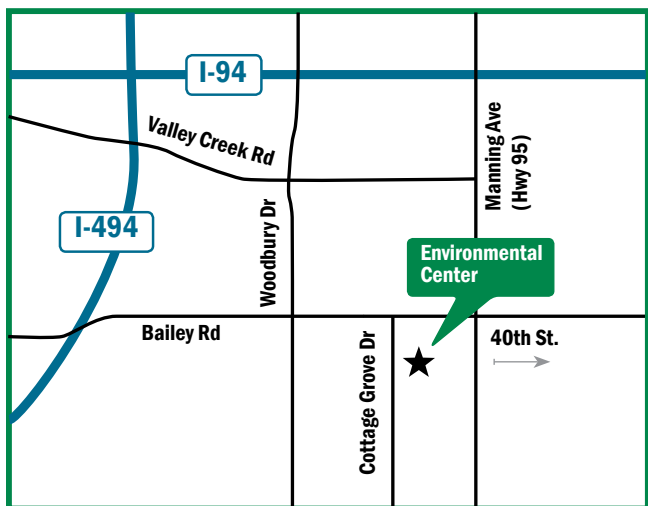
