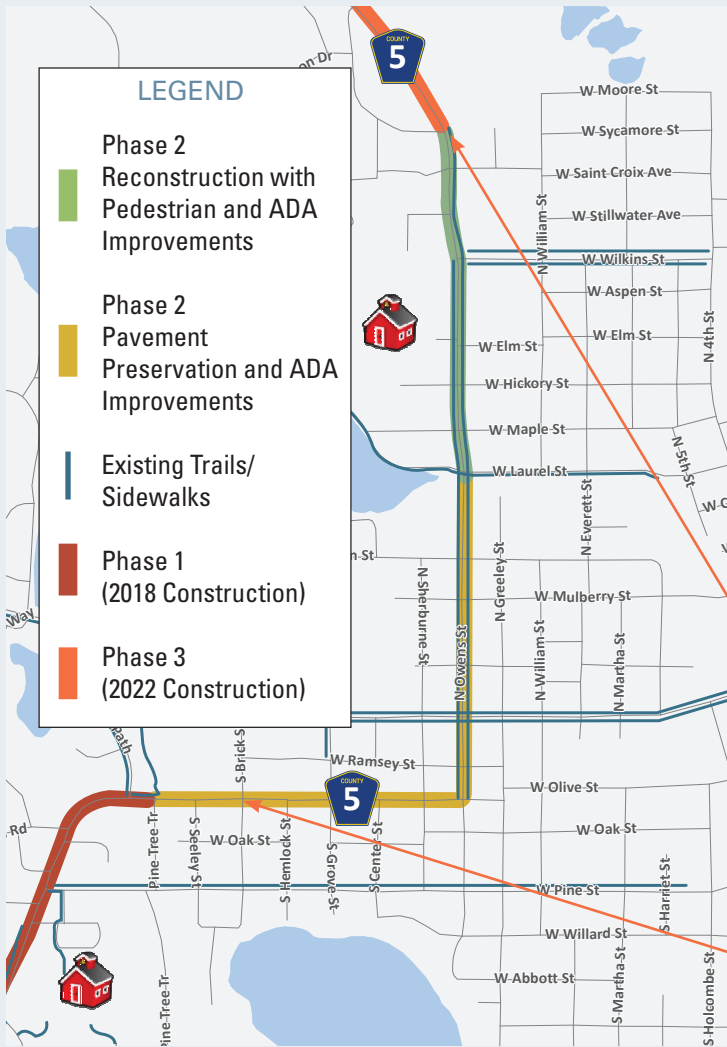

PLEASE JOIN US

County Road 5 is an important north-south link in the City of Stillwater. However, it currently lacks adequate pedestrian and bicycle accommodations and connectivity among facilities. Washington County conducted a study in 2014 that considered ways to make the 2.5 mile stretch safer and provide a pedestrian and bicycle-friendly infrastructure.

Phase 1 of the project from Croixwood Boulevard to Pine Tree Trail is currently under construction. Phase 2 of the project between Pine Tree Trail and Sycamore Street includes:

- Add a sidewalk on each side of CSAH 5 between County Road 64 and the south junction of Sycamore Street W
- Potential impacts to on-street parking in some areas to accommodate pedestrian and safety improvements.
- Stripe left turn lanes at Brick Street S
- Resurface County Road 5
