Accepted at Drop Box

NOT accepted at Drop Box

- No needles, used Epipens, syringes, lancets or thermometers
- No liquid chemotherapy drugs

Preparing for drop-off

- No need to cross off your name—drop-off is anonymous (no ID required)
- Keep medications in original container
- If you don't have the original container, place in small bag
