



Washington County Parks Campground Policies and Rules

- All campers must register in person or by phone with the Park Office.
- Washington County Parks vehicle permits are required. Daily Permit: \$7 Annual Permit: \$30
- **No alcohol, pets, unapproved firewood, fireworks, parking on grass/roadway, burning trash, gathering of firewood, smoking at beaches/playgrounds or unattended fires.**
- **Check-In:** 3pm **Check Out:** 1pm **Re-Register:** by 11am **Quiet Hours:** 10pm-8am
- Maximum of 8 people per site (except group site).
- Only one camping unit (tent or camper) is allowed per site (except Group Camp sites). One additional tent may be allowed for minor children under 18.
- Campers under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Park gates close overnight 10pm-6am. Obtain a gate code from the Office for after-hours access.
- Weekends: 2-night minimum stay (Friday and Saturday) Holidays: 3-night minimum stay
- 14 day maximum stay at any Washington County campground in any 30 day period
- Cancellations must be made at least 48 hours in advance of scheduled check-in to receive a refund of your camping fee (the \$8.00 reservation fee is non-refundable).
- Washington County reserves the right to move campers to different sites than requested due to unforeseen circumstances and/or to ask any camper to leave.
- Washington County Ordinance governs activities in County Parks. A copy is available to review in the office.
- 10 MPH speed limit
- Fires permitted in fire rings or self-contained grills only.
- Trash/Recycling must be deposited in dumpsters located at the entrance of the Modern Campground
- Keep food stored in camper or vehicle.
- Extra vehicles and visitors must park in the visitor/overflow parking lots.
- Vehicles and camping units must park on gravel site pads. Boat trailers may park on the grass.
- **CALL 911** in the event of an emergency or disruption. Sheriff Non-Emergency: 651-439-9381.
- Emergency Alert Sirens activate if a Tornado Warning has been issued.
- **DESIGNATED STORM SHELTERS:** Shower/restroom buildings
