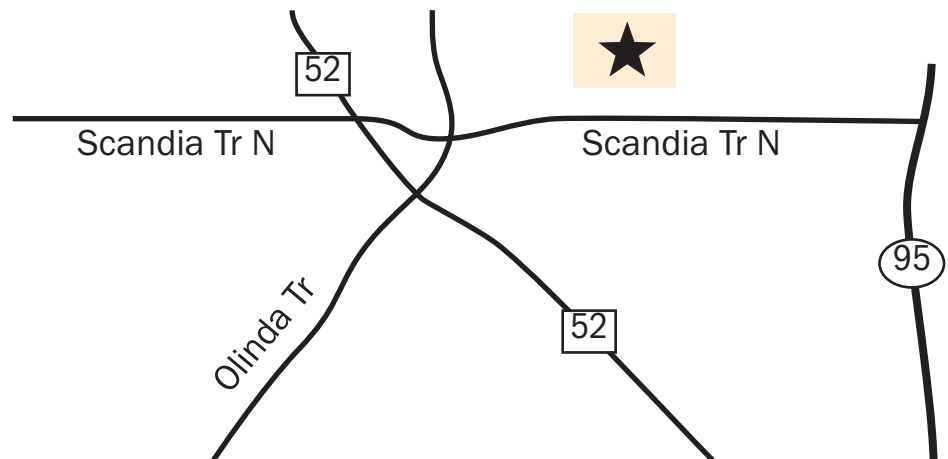

- No needles, used Epipens, syringes, lancets or thermometers
- No liquid chemotherapy drugs
- No vaping devices or e-liquids
