

Non-Traditional Opportunities for Women: Free Training

Eligibility

Women who are residents of Minnesota **and one of the following:** age 50+, a person of color, or low income.

Services

Funds are available to pay for short-term training leading to work that is considered non-traditional for women, in-demand and with good wages.

- Work 1:1 with an employment counselor
- Interest and values assessments
- Career exploration and labor market research
- Develop a training and job search plan
- Financial assistance
- Job search assistance

Training & Job Title Examples

- Construction or commercial painters
- Welders
- Heavy truck drivers (CDL)
- Highway maintenance workers
- CNC operators
- Glaziers (specialty occupation in construction)

Average starting pay, metro area = \$18.02
