Student Judges

To work as an election judge a student must:

- Be 16 or 17 on or before Election Day
- Be a US citizen in good academic standing at a Minnesota High School (or home schooled).
- Obtain school and parental permission.
- Serve in the county or adjacent county where you reside.
- Be willing to serve in a patient, honest and impartial manner
- Cannot be related to another judge in the same precinct
- Cannot be related to a candidate on the ballot
- Be able to read, write and speak English
